### NORTH WINS OVER SOLID SOUTH

land, Or., Nov. 3.—At 12 o'clock the Associated Press reported that returns indicated the election of Taft by a landslide, the Republican candidate carrying every northern state with the possible exception of Nebraska and New Jersey. Joseph Cannon is re-elected. The election will be overwhelmingly Republican. Taft (Rep.) defeats Stevenson for governor of Illinois. Taft has carried Oregon by at least 25,000, and returns received indicate that he has carried every county in the state. Taft is elected governor of New York. Every county will go for Taft by at least 1300.

**CARRIED IN COOK COUNTY**  
 Nov. 4.—The City Press says incomplete returns from election districts in Cook county of Chicago indicate a total vote of 26,000; Taft's plurality, 13,000; county outside of Chicago 19,000.

 2529 districts of New York outside of Greater New York give Taft, 482,224; Bryan, 326,233.

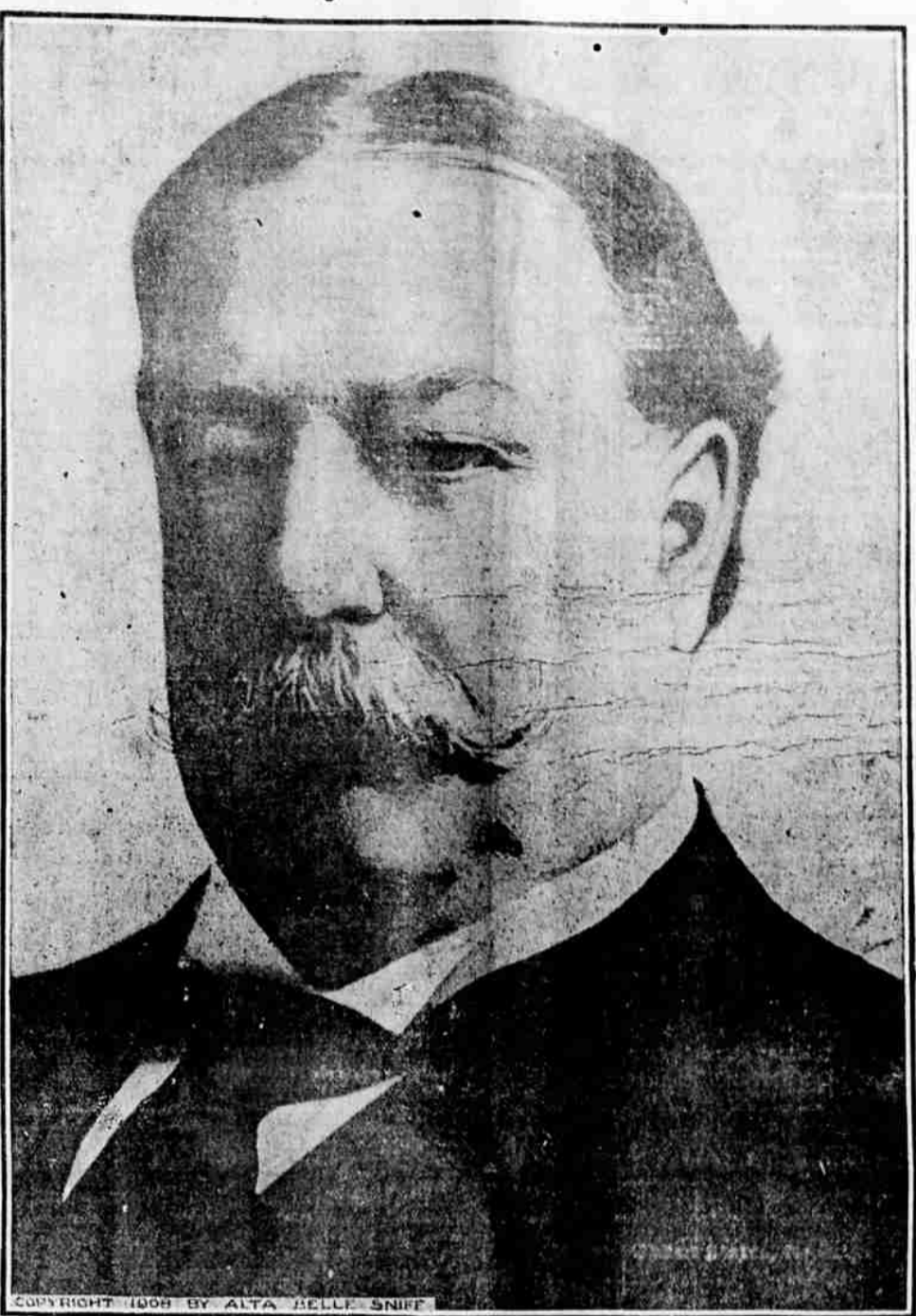
**MICHIGAN DEMOCRATS MAY ELECT GOVERNOR**

 Reno, midnight.—The Republican state chairman concedes Nevada to Bryan by about 3000 majority.

**JOHN JOHNSON MAY BE BEATEN**  
 St. Paul.—At midnight the Minneapolis Journal claims a landslide for Taft with chances for Jacobson, Republican, for governor.

## TAFT IS ELECTED AND REPUBLICANS MAKE CLEAN SWEEP

New York, Nov. 3.—11 p. m.—The Herald says that Taft has 306 electoral votes and a plurality of 150,000 in New York—also that Hughes wins by close to 45,000 plurality.

**SWEEPING TAFT VICTORY**  
 New York, Nov. 4.—Indications are that the following votes will be cast in the electoral college for Taft: California, 10; Connecticut, 7; Delaware, 3; Idaho, 3; Illinois, 27; Indiana, 15; Iowa, 13; Kansas, 10; Maine, 6; Massachusetts, 16; Michigan, 14; Minnesota, 11; New Hampshire, 4; New Jersey, 12; New York, 39; North Dakota, 4; Ohio, 23; Oregon, 4; Pennsylvania, 34; Rhode Island, 4; South Dakota, 4; Utah, 3; Vermont, 4; Washington, 5—total, 275. Bryan, 108.

**CARRIES NEW YORK CITY**  
 Taft may have a majority in New York City, the first time the big city has given its vote to a Republican president. Taft will probably receive a greater plurality in New York state than did Roosevelt four years ago.

**PAPERS SAY IT IS TAFT**  
 New York, 12 m.—Herald, Times and Brooklyn Eagle all declare Taft elected.

**WISCONSIN FOR TAFT**  
 Associated Press bulletin, Milwaukee—Meagre returns from different points in Wisconsin indicate that Wisconsin is safe for Taft and that Davison, Republican, for governor, is running about even with Taft.

**BRYAN CARRIES OWN PRECINCT**  
 Lincoln—Bryan carries his precinct, 106 to 52. Omaha, complete—Bryan, 10,732; Taft, 10,609. 65 precincts outside of Omaha and Douglas county give Taft, 7099; Bryan, 7336.

**TAFT CARRIES IOWA**  
 Des Moines, Iowa—80 precincts in Iowa indicate Taft's majority will be 78,000.

**BIG TAFT MAJORITY.**  
 Philadelphia, Nov. 4.—Senator Penrose claims a plurality of over 250,000 for Taft in Pennsylvania.

**STEVENSON LEADING**  
 Chicago—Vote for governor—103 out of 1260 precincts in Chicago give Deneen 135,816; Stevenson, 144,166.

**CONNECTICUT FOR TAFT**  
 Hartford, Conn., Nov. 4.—The Republican state committee claims the state by 40,000 majority for Taft.

**IDAHO REPUBLICAN**  
 Boise, Idaho, Nov. 4.—Only meagre returns have been received, but they indicate that Taft has carried the state by about 20,000, and that Brady, Republican, for governor, and the entire Republican ticket has been elected by a majority of from 7000 to 12,000.

**WASHINGTON BY 40,000**  
 Seattle, Wash., Nov. 3.—Washington state polls did not close until 8 p. m., but indications are that Taft carries the state by 40,000 plurality and entire state is safely Republican.

**TAFT CARRIES CALIFORNIA**  
 San Francisco, Nov. 4.—Partial returns from 16 precincts out of 300 in San Francisco give Taft, 1250; Bryan, 795; Debs, 144. For justice supreme court, Dunn 971; Cook 899.

California indications at 9:50 p. m. are that Taft has carried the state by a large plurality.

**OREGON RETURNS**  
 Portland, Or., 12 m.—Partial returns from 13 counties in Oregon outside of Multnomah give Taft, 16,213; Bryan, 94 15.

**MARYLAND FOR TAFT**  
 Baltimore, midnight—Taft carries Baltimore by 2000 and has carried the state by 5000.

**NORTH DAKOTA, TOO**  
 Fargo, Nov. 4.—The Republican state committee claims North Dakota for Taft by a substantial plurality.

### OREGON FOR TAFT BY 25,000 VOTES, SAYS OREGONIAN

Portland, Or., Nov. 4.—The Oregonian states that Taft has carried Multnomah by 8000, and this will give Taft a plurality of 25,000.

Seven precincts in Umatilla county give Taft, 1158; Bryan, 314; Chaffin, 5; Debs, 23.

Forty precincts in Multnomah county give Taft, 6460; Bryan, 3574.

Portland, Or.—Partial returns from 19 counties in Oregon outside of Multnomah county give Taft, 8245; Bryan, 4836; Chaffin, 141; Debs, 458; Higgen, 4. These counties gave Roosevelt 20,825 and Parker 3893 in 1904.

Milwaukee, Wis.—21 precincts outside of Milwaukee give Taft, 1371; Bryan, 734.

Chicago—934 precincts out of 1260 in Chicago give Taft 144,317; Bryan, 104,421.

Louisville, Ky.—Louisville and Jefferson county, 124 precincts out of 222, Taft, 15,477; Bryan, 12,863.

Kentucky—7 counties complete out of 119, Bryan 9111; Taft 7008.

Minneapolis, Minn.—46 precincts in Minneapolis give Taft 5579; Bryan, 2918.

Omaha—48 precincts in Omaha and Douglas county give Taft 9514; Bryan, 9572.

Chicago, Ill.—462 out of 1260 precincts in Chicago—Taft, 137,656; Bryan, 109,640.

City of New York—755 districts out of 1633 give Taft 128,887; Bryan 126,108; Higgen, 12,854.

Concord, N. H.—Forty towns and wards out of 290 in New Hampshire, Taft, 4388; Bryan, 2391.

Sioux Falls, N. D.—25 precincts out of 2300 in South Dakota give Taft, 2461; Bryan, 1162.

Denver—Returns from state are coming in slowly and count thus far shows Republicans in the lead by a small majority.

Salt Lake.—Sixteen districts in the city and county give Taft, 4387; Bryan, 2916. Total vote cast in city and county will be about 36,000.

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
