INSURANCE ADJUSTED AT COTTAGE GROVE

Twelve Thousand Dollars On Garman-Hemenway Block Paid in Full

The insurance adjusters in the Garman-Hemenway Company's fire loss finished their work Saturday. After examining the firm's books an estimate of \$21,000 was placed on the merchandise loss and the \$12,000 insurance is said to have been paid in full. The company will now conduct a fire sale of damaged goods. O. O. Veatch, the owner of the building, was allowed his insurance in full, amounting to only \$2000, which will only partially cover the loss, but Mr. Veatch will proceed at once to rebuild and remodel his two-story brick. Andy Graham, formerly a hotel keeper of this city, but now of Seattle, is spending a few days in Cottage Grove looking after business matters.
