### RAY LAMPHERE WILL BE TRIED

Alleged Accomplice of Notorious Mrs. Belle Gunness  
LaPorte, Ind., Nov. 5.—Interest in the Gunness murder cases, which excited the attention of the entire country last spring, will be revived next week when Ray Lamphere, alleged to have been the right-hand man of Mrs. Belle Gunness in conducting her murder farm, is placed on trial. Lamphere is under indictment for the murder of Mrs. Gunness and her three children by burning her farm house and is charged also with complicity in the killing of several of the woman's victims.  
It is probable the youth will be tried first for the murder of Mrs. Gunness, although the prosecuting attorney claims to have a very strong case against him on the charge of complicity in the murder of Andrew Helgelein.

Helgelein, who was a South Dakota farmer, came here with \$2,300 after a correspondence with Mrs. Gunness and was never more heard of. He was but one of a dozen or more men who are believed to have fallen victims to the murder of Helgelein. Lamphere is charged with complicity in the murders of several others; but the killing of Helgelein, which is said to have occurred January 14, last, is believed to furnish the strongest case against him.  
The destruction of the Gunness house and the burning of the widow and her three children occurred on the night of April 28. It came as a climax to a strenuous investigation by a brother as to the whereabouts of Albert Helgelein, who is believed to have been the last victim of Mrs. Gunness. Helgelein was lured to the Gunness farm through a matrimonial advertisement. After his arrival he was induced to turn into the woman's hands nearly \$3,000, which he had earned as a rancher on his section of land near Aberdeen, S. D. It is the accepted belief of the authorities that the activity of Helgelein's brother in investigating the mystery of the former's disappearance led Lamphere to put the widow and her children out of the way in order to save himself.  
Lamphere had been employed for some years on the Gunness farm and that he had a guilty knowledge of the nefarious traffic carried on by the widow seems certain. Considerable doubt exists, however, as to the extent of his complicity in the whole series of murders. He logically appears in the light of a possible accomplice, or the theory that the woman could not have done her murderous work alone, however, his apparent willingness to be coupled with the responsibility of his antecedents, and his own lack of opportunity, convinced many persons here that the case

that Lamphere either is not guilty or was at best a mere tool in the hands of the exceptionally intelligent and cold-blooded murderers.

### REV. M. T. WIRE AND MRS. HUTCHINSON WED

Son of Rev. M. C. Wire Marries Widow of Y. M. C. A. Worker Who Was Murdered

The marriage of Mrs. Reno Hutchinson and Rev. Melville T. Wire, yesterday afternoon at the parsonage of the Grace Methodist church at Portland, came as a surprising piece of news to many of the friends of the couple when it was made known this morning. The ceremony was quiet, performed by Rev. W. R. Heppie, and witnessed only by the minister's family.  
Mr. Wire is prominent among the younger men in the Oregon conference of his church. He was for three years pastor of the Patton Methodist Episcopal church, and at the last conference was transferred to the Columbia river conference. He is a graduate of the Garrett Biblical Institute at Evanston, Ill., and is a product of Oregon Methodism. He served for the past two years as secretary of the conference.  
Mrs. Wire has been the contralto in the Grace Methodist choir. Her beautiful voice has been much admired. She was the widow of the late Reno Hutchinson, an energetic worker in the Y. M. C. A., whose tragic death at Spokane so shocked his many friends about two years ago. Mr. Hutchinson was shot and killed at night by an assassin whose identity was never discovered.
