FOOTBALL RALLY

WILL BE HELD TOMORROW NIGHT

Game Saturday Is the Most Important to Be Played in Eugene

The football game with the University of Washington Saturday afternoon in Kincaid Field will be the greatest game at Eugene this year, as well as the last. In honor of the game, tomorrow night the students will hold one of their big rallies on Kincaid Field. There will be speeches, songs, marches and a bonfire, under the direction of Yell Leader Loosely.

The Oregon student body and team feel the situation to be a desperate one, and demanding every vestige of the famous Oregon spirit. In fact, enthusiasm promises to be higher for this game than at any time for the past two years, when such demands were not put upon enthusiasm by a defeat.

No hard bucking was done last night, the players running through the signals, and it is likely to do so Saturday. While it is not unusual to have anyone but the quarter direct the plays, as the candidates have had little experience in college games, it has been thought advisable to try the plan of trusting to the older backfield men.

The Oregon work will be lighter the rest of the week from that of the first part. The team seems to be working together better. Voight, guard, is disabled with a bruise on one of his legs and is not likely to play Saturday. Besides Gilles, with his 195 pounds and experience, there is Sweek and Newton. Sweek is a little light, but fights hard. Newton is a very powerful man, but has not played football long enough to fully know how to use his weight and strength.

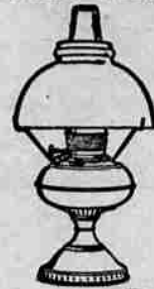

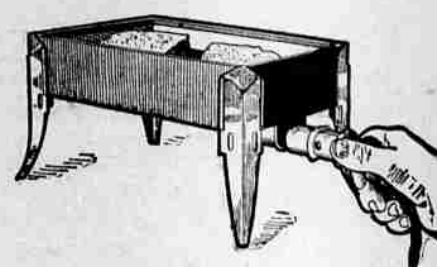
