EUGENE BOY WINS FAME AS HORIZONTAL BAR PERFORMER
 Has Been With Norris & Rowe Circus—Leaves Sunday for Australia

Frank Cherry, who is now visiting his parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. W. Cherry, in this city, has won distinction in the past year or two as an acrobat and horizontal bar and trapeze performer. He has been with the Norris & Rowe circus during the past season, joining the show at Portland after it appeared in Eugene last spring. He made a tour of the country with the circus, going all through the Eastern states and up into Canada, and as far south as Mexico. The circus has just put into winter quarters at Santa Cruz, Cal., and Frank came on up to Eugene to visit his parents for a few days. He will leave San Francisco next Sunday for Australia with a troupe of acrobats known as the Honoy family. They will tour Australia and probably New Zealand, and expect to be back to America within a year.

Frank learned the business in Portland during the past few years, and is now among the top notchers in his line. He says he likes the work, but traveling with a circus is a hard life, he says, as his career will be watched with interest by his many friends here.

SIMON KLOVD AHL COMPLETES HIS NEW COUNTY MAP
 Complete and Up-to-Date Map of Lane County, Showing Latest Boundaries

Simon Klovdahl, the civil engineer, has just completed a fine new map of Lane county which he has placed on the market selling them for \$10 each. This is the first map made of the county since Jos. Koch's map made fifteen years ago. New features of the map are as follows: Every township is an exact copy of the official survey, showing topography and all subdivisions, and gives acreage of all fractions; all original donation claims are shown so that any description of land, large or small, can be located, whether it is part of a section or part of a donation; new and correct boundaries of the county, of which can be mentioned the portion annexed from Douglas county, including Tallcoos Lake on the southwest corner, the Linn county boundary to the northeast, and the mountain boundary with Douglas to the southeast; the new precinct divisions; county roads up to date; all the national forest boundaries, both in the Cascade as well as the Umpqua ranges; school houses, with district numbers; a special feature of much value to mountaineers is the correction of the unsurveyed portion of the Cascade mountains by data obtained from private surveys. Streams, mountains, trails, and noted landmarks have been added or corrected; the proposed Natron-Klamath railroad and the electric railroad from Junction City through Eugene, Springfield and up the McKenzie.

MATRON OF ATWOOD'S HOSPITAL BEING TRIED IN PORTLAND
 On Charge She Has Failed to Exercise Proper Care Over Adopted Children

That criminal operations were performed at the Dr. Atwood maternity hospital at Tremont station was the testimony of John Roberts, of Gaston, Or., in the juvenile court this morning, where a jury of six men is trying Miss May Petty, matron of the institution, on the charge that she has failed to exercise proper care and guardianship over her two adopted children, three and two years of age, says the Journal.

The testimony of Roberts was brought out by District Attorney Moeschel for the purpose of showing the character of the place where Miss Petty was employed. Other testimony of the morning was to the effect that the little girls, or at least the older one, had been present with her foster mother in the operating room while the doctors were at work. One witness testified that Miss Petty admitted this when examined in the district attorney's office.

Roberts, when called to the stand, said his wife had been a patient at the Atwood "hospital." That was about two years ago.

Irene Hinton, a nurse at the hospital for eight months, testified that the older child was in the room when the witness' tonsils were removed, and that the child was present during a portion of the time while other operations were performed. She declared, however, that the child was seated on a high chair that was not in view of the operating table.

The object of the proceedings is to have the children permanently taken from the custody of Miss Petty. Several witnesses testified that the little girls have not had proper care. The grand jury visited the institution about two weeks ago and presented a report that forms the basis of the present trial. Since the exposure of the practices at the hospital the children have been in the care of the Boys' and Girls' Aid Society.
