### LOUIS RENNINGER FOUND DEAD IN HIS SON'S BARN

Thought At First He Had Been  
Kicked by Mules, But Doc-  
tor Says Heart Trouble

A telephone message to The Guard from Marcola last evening brought the information that the dead body of Louis Renninger, a well-known old time resident of that place, had been found in his son's barn. It was thought that he had been kicked to death by two mules as he was found lying face downward on the barn floor between the animals.

Mr. Renninger was last seen alive Tuesday evening when he left his home for his son's farm about a half mile distant. He failed to return at the appointed time and his family becoming alarmed, instituted a search for him. Finally he was found about six o'clock last evening, dead, in the barn.

A telephone message was sent to Coroner Gordon in Eugene, telling him of the death of the old gentleman and he sent instructions to Justice of the Peace McKibben to investigate the case and if he thought it necessary to conduct an inquest. The Justice of the peace was accompanied from Marcola by Dr. Pollard and other citizens of that town. After a careful examination the doctor and the Justice of the peace came to the conclusion that the man died from heart trouble, as they could find no marks of violence on his body. Taking these facts into consideration, an inquest was deemed unnecessary.

Mr. Renninger was an old soldier and was a member of J. W. Geary post, G. A. R. of Eugene.

### PLANNING FOR GREAT CORN SHOW

Springfield, Ill., Nov. 19.—All arrangements are practically complete for the great corn show to be held in this city during the coming week. The exhibition will occupy three buildings and is destined to be the largest affair of its kind ever given in this country. The chief purpose of the promoters of the show is to interest the corn growers throughout the country, in the modern, scientific ways of raising corn, so that the yield and the quality may be increased and improved.

Besides the corn itself, there will be exhibits of kindred cereals and grasses, feed and farm machinery and displays of most of the 107 by-products, showing the process from the raw material to the market article. The corn kitchen will show the many ways corn is used as a food, and there will be a course of lectures by men high in the agricultural world on the scientific raising of corn. The agricultural department of the University of Illinois will have charge of the educational features of the exhibition.
