SEPARATE FROM Y. M. C. A. AT UNIVERSITY

Some question has arisen as to the relation between the proposed association and the students' association at the University. The latter has been organized for several years and has been doing effective work along social and religious lines among the students. Some four or five years ago a movement was started to secure a student building which would be used for the student association and other student organizations, such as the Y. M. C. A., debating societies, glee club, athletic headquarters, etc. Several subscriptions were secured, but it was thought unwise to conduct the campaign for sufficient funds to erect the building, and so consent was secured from a number of the subscribers in Eugene to allow their subscriptions to go toward the purchase of a lot which was to be retained until such time as it seemed wise to go ahead. Accordingly a lot was purchased at the corner of the campus, costing \$1100.00. It is probable that sometime in years to come a student building will be erected there which will be for the use of all student organizations, and under the control of the college Y. M. C. A.

The building for which funds are now being secured will be erected on the lot on Willamette street between Tenth and Eleventh, and will be primarily for the boys and young men of the town. No doubt many university students whose homes are in the city, and others who may wish to avail themselves of the privilege will be members of the city organization as well as the other. A combination membership will doubtless be arranged for.

It should be borne in mind that the majority of young men in Eugene, between the ages of eighteen and twenty-five are not attending the university.

If at some time in the future it becomes necessary for a student building, funds will be raised all over the state for the purpose.

WATTS FOR WATCHES

CRIMSON VERSUS BLUE ON GRIDIRON BATTLE TOMORROW

New Haven, Nov. 20.—The advance guard of an army of thousands of visitors has reached here, eager and enthusiastic over tomorrow's football game between the Harvard and Yale elevens. The downtown streets are resplendent with the colors of the two big universities, and there are many other outward and visible signs that the great gridiron contest of the year is at hand.

Both of the teams are in quarters awaiting the signal that will call them to victory or defeat. Reports are to the effect that all the players are in excellent shape and a spirit of confidence pervades both camps. Seldom in recent years have the Harvard men entertained a feeling of greater confidence in the result. The general impression is that the teams are more evenly balanced this year than usual. Unless all signs are misleading, it will be a game well worth witnessing.

The game tomorrow will be the 29th since 1876, in which year Yale football was introduced at Yale and Harvard. Of the games played Yale has won 21 and Harvard 3. There have been three tie games. In 1877, 1885, 1888, 1895 and 1896 the teams did not meet. Harvard has not won since 1901, in which year she was victorious by a score of 22 to 9. Since then it has been a continuous string of wins for the Elis.

ATTORNEY RALPH FISHER'S LIFE IS THREATENED

Ralph B. Fisher, who is the prosecutor of the Oregon State Bar Association, has informed the police that for some weeks past he has been receiving anonymous letters threatening his life, says the Journal. Mr. Fisher has been appearing as prosecutor against several members of the bar against whom disbarment proceedings have been instituted, and it is supposed that some one of them has taken this method of trying to induce the prosecutor to drop the charges.

Another letter was received this morning, typewritten and purposely misspelled, so as to hide the writer's identity. It reads as follows:

"Mr. R. Fisher:
"Sir:
From rumors I have heard you are to be shot or disposed of, and I think my duty to tell you to be careful. Of course this may only be talk but the shooting of Mr. Heney makes the matter worse. If it were known that I had warned you it would be bad for me."

Attorney Fisher is well-known in Eugene, where he has visited frequently. He is a nephew of Mrs. J. M. Shelley.
