A rate of one and one-third fare has been granted from points on the Southern Pacific to Eugene, provided 25 or more tickets are purchased to Eugene. Delegates will secure a receipt from the agent when they purchase ticket to Eugene. This entitles them to one-third fare on the return trip. It is very important to have this receipt.
Sessions of the Conference will be held in the First Presbyterian church except on Friday evening.
