**SECRETARY STRAUS
MAKES MANY NEW
RECOMMENDATIONS**

Washington, Dec. 1.—Important and unusual statements and recommendations are made by Secretary Oscar S. Straus, in the sixth annual report of the Department of Commerce and Labor, made public today. Mr. Straus lays particular stress upon the inefficiency of the methods employed by the government in excluding undesirable Chinese, and suggests that the laws be changed. He points out that while aliens of other countries are denied admission to the United States under the general immigration laws, the exclusion of the Chinese is secured only after a lengthy procedure in the Federal Courts.

Mr. Straus explains that aliens of all countries say China can be deported on order of the Secretary of Commerce and Labor, but that the Chinese can carry their case to the courts. He shows by records that the only result in the latter method is to prolong the investigation needlessly, with detriment to the country. The investigation of other foreigners arrested for being unlawfully in this country extends over but a few days. He said:

Makes Recommendation.
The obvious course to pursue, therefore, dictated alike by the demands of justice and equality on one hand and by considerations of good administration on the other, is to place the matter of Chinese immigration where it essentially belongs, namely within the operation of the system of regulation applicable to immigration generally; in other words, to let the methods and the machinery provided with respect to the admission and exclusion of aliens generally be applied in the case of aliens from China as well. Should this be done, among other results which may confidently be expected are in the first place, an enormous gain, in effectiveness or enforcement, particularly with reference to the deportation of those who have secured unlawful access to the country; second, a most decided gain in economy of administration, and third a marked improvement in the relations between two friendly peoples as

well as a notable increase in commercial prestige.

Particular attention is devoted by the Secretary in his report to the Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization, Corporations and Labor. While other bureaus of the department are important, the three mentioned bear the most directly upon the material interests of the people than do any of the others. The report, as it relates to them scarcely can be considered as an ordinary department report, as it is replete with information, suggestion, and human interest.

**OREGON ELECTRIC
SPENDS \$3,000,000**

That the Oregon Electric has expended \$3,000,000 in placing its line in the present state of improvement is shown by a report filed with the state railroad commission yesterday afternoon.

The report is in typewritten form and is in response to a request for a statement as to cost since the starting of the road.

The report shows that the road has 70 miles of main line in operation and five miles of industrial and passing tracks. The roadbed is constructed after the pattern of a standard steam road. It has 15-foot embankments and is fully ballasted.

All trestle bridges are said to be standard, and will bear any class of equipment. A steel bridge with deck spans is stretched across the Willamette river at Wilsonville and was constructed at a cost of nearly a quarter of a million dollars. The company, according to the report, has four concrete sub-power stations, one brick and eight ordinary and are constructing three other standard stations beside tool and section houses. All agency stations are provided with tool and section houses and closets. At Portland the company has constructed a concrete freight station.—Salem Statesman.

IS MORAL COWARD**
