### MANY MILLIONS ASKED FOR COAST IMPROVEMENTS

Washington, Dec. 7.—The secretary of the treasury today sent to congress the following estimates:  
 Completion of Albany building, \$50,000; completion of Eugene building, \$30,000; completion of La Grande building, \$45,000; completion of Pendleton building, \$48,000; Columbia river quarantine station cabin and passenger barracks, \$15,000; steamer passenger barracks, \$10,000; Vancouver barracks, two double barracks, \$114,000; one field artillery barracks, \$42,000; improvements at Fort Stevens, \$21,000; purchase of target range, Vancouver barracks, \$11,800; mouth of the Columbia river, \$450,000; Celilo canal, \$1,164,000.  
 All other recommendations for river and harbor appropriations are renewed, and for Crater Lake Park \$21,745 is asked.

"We do not propose to have the President at Washington dictate our course in this matter," he continued. "Furthermore, we will derive an advantage from his published announcement in that it insures for us support of many influential Republicans, who frequently have had occasion to differ from the President in some of his policies in the past. But for the positive and unqualified position the President has taken on this senatorial fight we would not be able to enlist the assistance of these influences in our fight."
