OREGON GETS \$25,854.30 FROM SALES OF LANDS

Washington, Dec. 9.—The general land office has made public its account with Oregon for the year ending June 30, 1908. Gross proceeds from the sale of public lands were \$540,881.58, from which amount is deducted the pro rata share of expenses chargeable to the state of \$10,849.26, making the net proceeds \$517,086.09 of which amount the state is entitled to 5 per cent or \$25,854.30.
