BERT KELSAY GIVEN PAROLE SENTENCE OF THREE YEARS

Creswell Youth, Charged With Perjury, Will Retain His Freedom—Linn Trial

Bert Kelsay, a Creswell youth, who pleaded guilty to the charge of perjury a few days ago, was given a parole sentence to the penitentiary of three years by Judge Harris this morning. He gave the boy a good lecture and stated that he allowed him his liberty on the condition that he keep out of trouble hereafter. The judge stated that if he was found intoxicated at any time, frequented saloons or was caught in any crime during the three years he would go to the penitentiary to serve out full time. The boy went to Portland to work, his father, B. S. Kelsay, having secured him a job of driving a team at \$5.00 a day.

Linn and Parsons Not Guilty.
The trial of Tom Linn, charged with selling liquor, was held today. The following jury was chosen: B. Jackson, Jr., Thos. Gray, L. M. Tozier, E. S. Prindle, Geo. Fisher, O. W. Brobbam, A. A. Gibson, E. F. Miller, Jas. Humphrey, G. T. Ray, and B. F. Goodpasture.

After the evidence was taken the attorneys for Linn made a motion that the jury be instructed to return a verdict of not guilty. The motion was sustained and the verdict was accordingly.

The jury, in the case of the state vs. Zach Parsons, accused of selling liquor on a second count, returned a verdict of not guilty this afternoon at one o'clock after having been out several hours.

LOUIS PRATT

RELIGIOUS FANATIC DIES IN HOSPITAL

Kansas City, Mo., Dec. 10.—Louis Pratt, wounded during a battle with the police, died at noon. Policeman Mullane suffered a relapse during the night and his life is hanging by a mere thread. Sergeant Patrick Clark and A. B. Selchist are slightly improved today. James S. Sharp, leader of the onslaught against the police, has not been captured.

Pratt's wife now says she knows Sharp was a false prophet. Policeman Mullane died at 1 o'clock today, making four deaths up to this hour.

BIG INCREASE

IN FREIGHT RATES ON NEW YEAR

Washington, D. C., Dec. 10.—Transcontinental freight tariffs, beginning January 1 next, will be advanced on all eastbound traffic by rail and water. The class rates on west bound traffic from the Atlantic seaboard to Pacific Coast points will be increased approximately ten per cent.

CONGRESSMEN

C., Dec. 10.—Leaders of the house and senate met for conference in Speaker Cannon's room this afternoon to consider what action, if any, should be taken concerning that portion of President Roosevelt's message which relates to secret service. Members of congress consider that part of the message as offensive.

OF IDAHO SOLONS

Boise, Dec. 10.—The Idaho supreme court today recommended to Governor Gooding that Idaho legislature should be called in special session on December 28 for the purpose of reviewing the work of the commissioner on revision of the Idaho code.

It is understood that Governor Gooding will act favorably.
