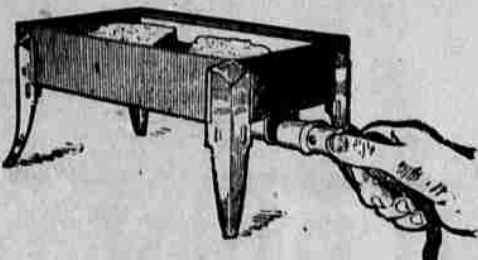

**THREE-STORY BLOCK WILL BE BUILT AT COTTAGE GROVE**

Dunbar & O'Lone Will Build—Delinquency Court to Be Held by O. N. G.

Messrs. Dunbar & O'Lone will erect a three-story brick building on their property with a basement. Plans are now in preparation, and a thoroughly up-to-date structure will be built. The basement will be of concrete and the three stories of pressed brick. A fine glass front will be put in and an electric elevator and steam heat will also come in with the modern utilities of the store. The basement will contain the grocery department, the ground floor the dry goods and the clothing, the second floor the ladies' ready-to-wear garments and shop rooms, and the third floor will contain furniture and carpets. The building, aside from the ground purchase, is estimated will cost between \$8,700 and \$9,000 complete, and will be another substantial improvement to this growing little city. The Garman-Hemenway Co. will move to their newly acquired property about the first of February. Mr. Lincoln will move as soon as he finds a location and workmen will remodel the interior of the present building, placing in a plate glass front and a balcony around the room. Work on the new brick will commence about the 1st of May, the coming spring, as soon as the peather permits. The present structure will be moved to the side street and Garman-Hemenway Co. will continue doing business in it until their new building is finished. This is an unexpected change in the building contemplated in this city, and with the present building in course of construction and a greater activity than the place has ever before seen will have started. Let the good work go on.

**CONFERENCE TO PROMOTE COMMERCE**

Washington, D. C., Dec. 10.—The fourth and last of the series of commercial and industrial conferences that have helped to make the present week a notable one in the national capital was held today, when the National Council of Commerce met to elect officers, adopt by-laws and to perfect a plan to be followed by the council in its future work. The sessions were held in the offices of the department of commerce and labor and were attended by eminent representatives of commercial organizations in virtually every state of the Union.

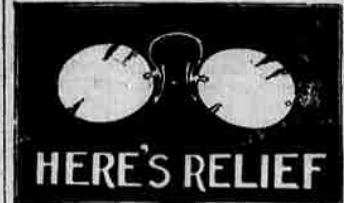
The National Council of Commerce, which was inaugurated by Secretary Straus a year ago, has aroused considerable interest throughout the country, about sixty commercial bodies from the leading cities of the United States having joined the council since its first meeting. Secretary Straus has become more and more convinced of the practical value of this progressive organization, not only to the commercial activities throughout the country, which can through the council be constantly informed of trade opportunities abroad, but to the vantage connected with the business world.

One of the features of the movement is the establishment of a permanent bureau of the council in this city in charge of a capable man, who can keep in close touch with the government departments that have to do with commercial affairs and advise the various commercial interests of important matters that arise from time to time and effect their welfare. Similar bureaus have existed for some time in Germany, England, France and other European countries and have found to be of incalculable value in promoting their foreign commerce.
