CIVIL SERVICE REFORM LEAGUE WILL HOLD MEETING NEXT WEEK

Pittsburg, Na., Dec. 12.—Final arrangements have been made for the twenty-eighth annual meeting of the National Civil Service Reform League, which will be held in this city next week. The program provides for four sessions, aside from a banquet, which will close the convention the evening of the second day.

The opening session Thursday will be devoted to addresses of welcome and reports, including the report from women's auxiliaries. At the second session addresses will be delivered by Joseph H. Choate, president of the league, and other speakers of national prominence. The third session will be a business meeting at which officers will be elected and the closing session will be given over to the reading of papers, one of them by Attorney General Charles J. Bonaparte, who, with President Roosevelt, is one of the charter members of the league.

All of the sessions will be open to the public and arrangements are being made to accommodate a large attendance.
