CHIEF JUSTICE SAYS ROOSEVELT IS AN ANARCHIST

New York, Dec. 14.—Indiana's but pointed criticism of Roosevelt's attitude toward the judiciary were made by Chief Justice Mitchell, of the Pennsylvania Society of New York at a banquet last night. The chief justice did not mention the trust law and made suggestions for chief executive by name, but left no doubt through quotations and allusions to various matters of public knowledge as to the object of his criticism. Mitchell among other things said:

"The only just criticism of a judge's law must come from a court which knows the law and has jurisdiction to declare it. Dissect from his views based on individual opinion of what the law ought to be, whether it comes from an executive or hoodlum, leads directly and by short steps to anarchy—the assertion of individual will against the settled law."

Mitchell pointed out that if the law is not what the people want it should be changed, "but let it never be lost sight of that the authority to change it is legislative and not judicial, still less executive."

Replying to the toast, "The bar of the country and the cause of federal justice," Attorney-General Bonaparte analyzed the so-called anti-trust law an dmade suggestions for its betterment. After declaring that Americans were a "Judge-ruled people," Bonaparte reviewed the conditions making necessary the anti-trust laws and declared the rich and powerful "stacked the cards; the dice were loaded against the humbler players; the smaller and weaker among the racers were crossed in their gallop and crowd off the

MRS. RALPH FISHER STUNNED BY MURDER OF HER HUSBAND

Though it was two weeks ago yesterday since Ralph Fisher, prosecutor for the Oregon State Bar Association's grievance committee, was shot down by James Finch, Mrs. Fisher, wife of the dead man, is yet unable to realize that her husband has been killed, and clasping his baby close in her arms she sits at home moaning and waiting for her husband to return, says the Salem Statesman.

Of all the details of this tragedy this is the most pathetic. Mrs. Fisher, a Salem girl, sister of T. B. Kay, one of Salem's prominent manufacturers and business men, cannot comprehend that her husband is not among the living.

These things are told by Roy T. Bishop, who is here from Portland for a number of days.

The assassination was of a peculiarly brutal kind because it occurred while Fisher was waiting for his wife and baby. They arrived a few minutes after the shooting, when the body had been taken away.

When the news was gently broken to Fisher's wife she seemed stunned and since the time has lived in a semi-comatose condition, scarcely believing that her husband is dead and hardly seeming to realize she will never see him again.

The farm value of all farm products of 1908 reaches the most extraordinary total in the nation's history—\$7,778,000,000. This is about four times the value of the products of the mines, including minerals, oils and precious metals. The farmer contributes 87 per cent of the raw materials used in those manufacturing industries which depend mostly upon agricultural materials, and these industries use 47 per cent of all materials used in all industries.

The gain in the value of farm products in 1908 over 1907 is \$290,000,000, and would have been much larger had not the prices of cotton and hay been low. The value of products in 1899, the census year, being taken at 125, for 1904, at 131; for 1905, at 134; for 1906, at 143; for 1907, at 159; and for 1908, at 165. During the last ten years the wealth production on the farms of this country has exceeded the fabulous sum of \$60,000,000,000.
