TWELVE FOOTBALL PLAYERS KILLED IN GRIDIRON SEASON

Three Hundred and Fifty Seriously Injured—Most of Them Prep Players

"Twelve dead and three hundred and fifty hurt," is the way the New York Post summarizes the football casualties of the 1908 season, which has just ended. Four of the twelve dead are members of college elevens. One is of the Virginia Military Institute, another of the University of North Carolina, a third of the Utah Agricultural college, and the fourth of the squad of Hugo Bezdek at the University of Arkansas.

The highest percentage of both injured and killed were among boys teams in the high and grammar schools. This has been the experience of the past years to such a degree, that some preparatory institutions have abolished the football game.

On all larger teams there were a great number injured during the past season. Both the captains of Harvard and Yale were seriously hurt during their gruelling schedule.

As a result of these facts the New York daily says that more changes in the rules of football will be compelled to be made by public opinion. Not only does the New York Post take up the subject in strong language, but so does the Record-Herald, the great Chicago paper, which wields such an influence in the Middle West.

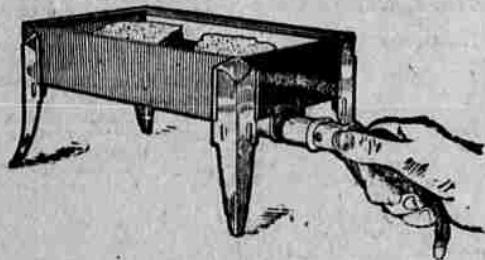
