TAX AT COTTAGE GROVE FOR A CITY PARK

Citizens Plan to Hold Election to Vote Four-Mill Levy For That Purpose

At a meeting of the Civic Improvement committee of the Woman's Club in the Cottage Grove Commercial Club parlors Saturday evening it was reported, after a canvass of the number of lots sold, the receipts from which were to apply on the purchase of the five-acre tract known as Long's grove, which is to be dedicated to the city for park purposes, that only sixteen lots have been contracted for by the business men and citizens of the city and as few more immediate purchasers are in prospect, other ways and means to raise funds with which to complete the purchase price for this beautiful natural park, were discussed and it was the consensus of opinion of those present that the most fair and equitable plan would be to levy a special four-mills tax for two years only, which would produce an adequate fund with which to purchase the park site and the net funds secured already from the sale of the sixteen town lots would be used in fencing, platting and beautifying the park. In fact, the Leader is authorized to state that the Civic Improvement committee stand ready to pledge \$1,000 to be used in fencing and beautifying the city park premises, if purchased by the proposed small special tax levy.
