GOVERNMENT MACHINERY CAN BE UTILIZED

Secretary of War Has Granted People of Siuslaw Use of Plant for Improvement

The following is a copy of a letter received by I. B. Cushman, of Acme, from Congressman Hawley. The property referred to is machinery and equipment for jetty building. Some time ago the county court made application to the war department for permission to use the plant now at Coquille in carrying out the project for building a jetty at the mouth of the Siuslaw river, and the letter from Mr. Hawley shows that such permission has been granted by the Secretary of War:

Washington, D. C., Dec. 9, 1908.
Mr. I. B. Cushman,
Dear Sir: I have just received the following letter from the Chief of Engineers United States Army: "Referring to your letter dated September 17, 1908, on the subject, I have the honor now to inform you that under date of the second instant the Secretary of War authorized the loan to the county court of Lane county, Oregon, of certain United States property and plant for use in connection with the county's project for the extension of the jetty at the mouth of the Siuslaw river, and the papers have today been returned to Major Melndos for his information and guidance."
