The new Valley league to be has proposed protection and rights from the National committee and will be in the ball market with the best amateur players obtainable by the time the season has fairly opened up. Arrangements have been made by the different town managers in the league for grounds, and Salem will probably put Asylum avenue park into use again, as this location is the most favorable of any in any distance of the city and will require but little labor to put it in first-class order.—Salem Journal.

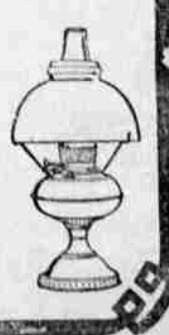
