**BIG UNION REVIVAL BEGINS AT PRESBYTERIAN**

Rev. H. Wyse Jones Preached Two Splendid Sermons Yesterday—Singer Delayed

Two great audiences greeted Evangelist Jones at the Presbyterian church yesterday. At the morning service, the sermon was on "Prayer," and at the evening service, Mr. Jones spoke on "Soul Winning." The key to the evangelist's success is doubtless found in these two sermons. Humble dependence upon God to save men and by kind and manly efforts win men. The manner of these workers is such as to commend itself to the sanest judgment of Christians who prefer permanent work to the more practical spectacular and short lived.

It was the general opinion of those who heard the sermons yesterday that Mr. Jones is one of the ablest men who ever preached in Eugene. Prof. Spear and wife were unavoidably detained and many were disappointed in not hearing them but they arrived last night and will direct the singing, assisted by a large choir and instruments tonight. Beginning with Tuesday an afternoon service will be held at the Presbyterian church at 3 o'clock. Services each night at 7:30 with song service and preaching.

**RIVER THREATENS THE CITY OF HARRISBURG**

Cutting Into Bank on Northeast Side—Water System Is Being Extended

Considerable damage is threatened by the Willamette river at Harrisburg. The river is cutting into the bank on the north-east side and is only a few yards from a row of houses.

Harrisburg is extending its water system. Outside of the mere cost of the pipe, the extension is very cheap, for the soil is so loose that a big plough suffices to dig the ditch. The road from Eugene to Coburg, and from that place to Harrisburg, is reported to be the best of all the highways north of Eugene.

The writer points out that "just as the mechanical world has changed and improved, so the world of labor has advanced from the slavery of the laborer to the day of his absolute independence and now to this day, when he begins to take his proper place as the capitalist-partner of his employer. We may look forward with the hope to the day when it shall be the rule for the workman to be partner with capital; the man of affairs giving his business experience, the workman in the mill his mechanical skill, to the company, both owners of the shares and so far equally interested in the success of their joint efforts, each indispensable, so that without their co-operation success would be impossible."
