MOTHER SHOT DEAD BY 9-YEAR-OLD SON

Mrs. J. G. Morris Victim of Tragedy in Farmhouse Near Corvallis

Corvallis, Or., Dec. 28.—Mrs. J. G. Morris was accidentally shot and killed at her home one and a half miles north of this city Sunday afternoon. A charge from a shotgun in the hands of a 9-year-old son, who did not know the gun was loaded, severed the large artery of the right leg and the woman bled to death in a very short time.

This fatality is the direct result of the forgetfulness of Mr. Morris, the victim's husband, who on returning from a hunting trip, laid his loaded gun on the table. The young son, who, it seems, had often been permitted to clean the firearm, picked it up for that purpose. The gun went off and Mrs. Morris, who stood by the stove, not ten feet distant, received the full charge.

It is said that Mr. Morris is all but insane over the tragedy. Mrs. Morris was about 48 years of age and the mother of a family, the majority of the children being grown.

Mrs. Morris was the niece of Mrs. A. W. Gilbert of Eugene, Or., and Mrs. Gilbert are there to attend the funeral.

MAKES TWO NEW WORLD'S RECORD SPRINTS

Johannesburg, South Africa, Dec. 27.—R. E. Walker, South African amateur sprinter, yesterday slipped down two world's amateur records at the Wanderer's sports. He brought Dan J. Kelly's Spokane record of 9 1/2 seconds for a 100 yards, down to 7 2/5 seconds and set the record of 11 2/5 seconds for the 120 yards. H. J. Weber of Georgetown university held the record for this sprint with 11 4/5 until Walker's showing today.
