NO GREAT DAMAGE
FROM STORM IN
LANE COUNTYFew Lambs Killed, Limbs Torn
From Shade Trees and
Many Colds Contracted

Snow, sleet, ice and rain have dominated the United States, the state of Oregon, Lane county and Eugene, in their turn during the last two days. In Lane county some lambs have been killed, a few limbs torn from shade trees, a few ankles sprained, and plenty of nasty colds have been contracted. Otherwise the damage has been light, although the river may yet break loose and raise out of its banks.

One stock man said he expected to lose a number of young lambs. Unless the storm is continued, the other stock will stand the cold without great suffering. In Eastern Oregon the winter has been hard, but in the western part of the state the autumn has been one of the best.

Snow in the mountains is deep, though some of the hills, which lie close to the valley have not been covered to any great depth. Others just as close seemed to have sufficient for the best skidding or sleighing. The temperature of the different localities has been very freakish, due to the fact that Lane county has been the battle ground between the warm chinooks of the south and the ice king of the north.

Perhaps the most real damage ultimately will be colds and other indirect troubles contracted from exposure. Such effects can not be estimated. Many people in the city had to go to their places of business through the slush, which was similar to wading in water half an inch deep, and the rain. Others had to perform tasks on the country roads. Literally there are thousands who could not stay in by a fire place, a coal heater, or in bed, and the death and sick list will never be compiled.
