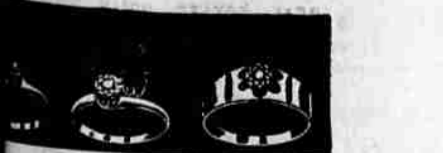

Washington, Jan. 7.—A cold wave is sweeping the North and Middle Atlantic States and shows no indication of breaking. The weather bureau publishes the following Northwest temperatures for the last 24 hours: Duluth, 26 below zero; Milwaukee, 19 below zero; Greenbay, Wis., 16 below zero; Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., 10 below zero; Dubuque, Iowa, 10 below zero; Valentine, Neb., 10 degrees below zero; Bismarck, N. D., 10 below zero; Moorhead, Minn., 22 below.
