JAMES PARVIN

Born May 2, 1831; died December 17, 1908. The subject of this brief sketch was born near the city of Indianapolis, Ind., his mother dying when he was only one year old. He began the battle of life on his own account in Fulton county, Illinois, whence his father had removed some years before. In the spring of 1853, in company with John Stoops, B. Rutledge, A. Matthews, James and Joseph Parker and many others, he set out to drive an ox team to far-away Oregon, which he reached in the fall of the same year and settled in Lost Valley, near the present site of Weston. In February, 1854, he was married to Silenta Parker, who remains to mourn the loss of a loved companion. To them were born nine children, three of whom, Mrs. Wm. Williams, of Dexter; H. M. Parvin, of Gettysburg, S. D., are still living. Mr. Parvin had for many years been a consistent member of the Christian church and it is enough to say that the close of his earthly career was as well ordered as his life had been. He will be greatly missed by a broad circle of friends and acquaintances. Virtue, the strength and beauty of the soul, is the best gift of heaven; a happiness that even above the smiles and flowers of fate, excites great nation's favorites, a wealth that never encumbers nor can be transferred.
