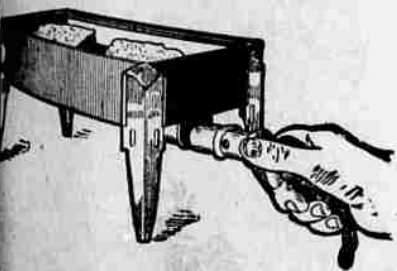

PORTION OF STABLE ROOF COLLAPSES

Snow Was Too Heavy For the South Annex to Kitchen & Komp's Livery Stable

The entire roof of the south annex to the Kitchen & Komp livery stable at the corner of East Seventh and Oak streets collapsed at 1 o'clock this morning from the weight of the heavy snow which covered it. There was not much slope to the roof of the annex and the snow, after it began to melt yesterday, did not go off of that part of the building very fast on that account. The heavy rain that fell all night soaked the snow and made it two or three times as heavy as it was before. About 11 o'clock last night the night man at the stable discovered that the roof had begun to sag and heard it crack several times. The proprietors were telephoned to and the horses which were quartered in that part of the building were taken out. The roof kept on cracking and finally at 1 o'clock gave way with a loud crash. Everything had been removed from the annex and there was no damage to anything except the building.

After the roof had fallen the roof of the main building began to crack and it was feared that it, too, would fall in. The horses and vehicles were all removed, but the snow on the roof melted rapidly and it was soon seen that the danger was over. The building is owned by Yates & Son, who built it five years ago. That portion of it where the roof fell in was formerly occupied by a blacksmith shop, but a year or two ago it was remodeled and has been used to stable horses since. The damage will amount to perhaps \$1000.

NEWS FROM LABOR WORLD

Italy is said to have a trade union membership of 150,000.

The number of quarrymen in Belgium is estimated at 37,000.

North Dakota will have a State Federation of Labor by next spring.

A child labor act, similar to that of Ontario, is planned for Alberta.

About one-half of the population of Greece are agriculturists and shepherds.

The headquarters of the Minnesota State Federation of Labor will be moved from Duluth to St. Paul.

Owing to a wage dispute 4000 men have struck at the Lamogate collieries, Rhondda Valley, Wales.

An attempt to establish a municipal brewery at Berlin resulted in a dismal failure. It did a good business, but lost money.

Efforts will be made at the automobile show, scheduled for Chicago February 5 to 13, to organize a national union of chauffeurs.

Of 505 deaths of sailors occurring in the experience of an industrial insurance company, 17.6 per cent are reported to have been due to accidents.

The formation of women's auxiliary unions in the labor movement is rapidly becoming popular, owing to its effect on the labor propaganda.

By the recent referendum vote taken by the bakers, a proposition to increase the salaries of the international officers was defeated by a large majority.

A campaign is to be started in San Francisco, with a view of obtaining for the women employed in stores higher wages and better conditions of employment.

Comparison shows that the wage rates paid in the United States are startlingly higher than in Great Britain, the difference varying from 20 to 20 per cent.

According to industrial insurance experience, the fatal accident rate of electricians and electric linemen is excessive. Of 645 deaths of electricians 14.7 per cent were due to accidents and of 240 deaths of linemen 46.7 per cent.

A conference of forty-seven delegates from traders' associations in and around London has just formed the London and Suburban Traders' Federation, which many local associations, representing 1200 tradesmen, have already joined.

looking to the enactment of a law by the Minnesota legislature, requiring that all meat cutters be subject to an examination as to their qualifications before a board of examiners appointed by the state.

Austin W. Bimms, of St. Louis, representing the Missouri State Federation of Labor, was the first to register as a lobbyist under the new state law, which requires the registration of all persons active in advancing measures before the state legislature.

It has been recommended that a national department of labor be established in England, presided over by a minister, with a seat in the cabinet, charged with the direction of that labor which has not been absorbed in the ordinary course, and that a permanent board for unemployed labor be established.
