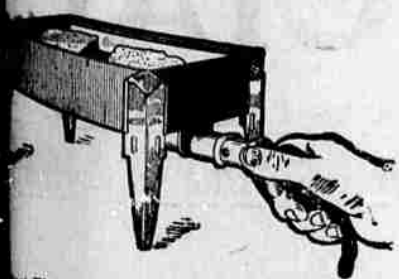

DRAYMEN NOW HAVE NO GARBAGE DUMP Stopped From Piling Trash and Manure in Gulch on East Fifth Street

Notices have been posted by the city authorities on the garbage dump at the gulch at the end of East Fifth street, where it intersects the S. P. railroad, notifying draymen and others that they are hereafter forbidden from dumping anything there. This has been used as a place to deposit a greater part of the city's garbage for several weeks past, but so much manure and other foul smelling materials have been hauled there that the stench has become almost unbearable to the people residing in that section of the city and they rightfully made complaint to the authorities with the result mentioned. The draymen say they are now up against it for a garbage dump. For years they used the property across the bridge and to the right of the road for such purpose, but this tract was fenced up a couple of years ago, and the gulch on East Fifth street was about the only available place left for that purpose. Something should be done in the way of providing a place for the garbage, as the draymen say they will leave it in the alleys and back yards for the want of a place to put it.

Pursuant to an order of the common council January 11th, 1909, bids will be received at the office of the city recorder until 7:30 p. m. January 25, 1909, for the improvement of the following streets in the city of Eugene:
Olive street, from Tenth to Eleventh.
West Eleventh street, from Olive street to Lincoln street, and
Pearl street, from Sixth street to Eleventh street.
By the construction of cement curbing along both sides of said streets and by paving said streets with bitulithic, asphalt or other hard surface pavement in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor prepared by the city engineer, and the provisions of ordinances Nos. 814, 815 and 816, all of said ordinances having been passed by the common council on the 2d day of December, 1908, and approved by the mayor on the 5th day of December, 1908.
Bidders will state price in detail in accordance with specifications prepared by the city engineer and now on file in the office of the city recorder. All work to be done under the supervision of the street committee, and to be approved by them. All contractors will be required to furnish an approved bond in a sum to be agreed upon for the faithful performance of his or their contract. And all bidders shall include with each bid a certified check in a sum equal to 5 per cent of the amount bid, payable to J. D. Matlock, mayor.
