## TUBERCULOSIS CAN BE DETECTED

### Dr. Pierce Speaks to University Students on the Dread White Plague

"Tuberculosis, the dread white plague, can be cured in seventy-five per cent of the cases, and can be detected by experts with absolutely sure tests," was one of the important statements of Dr. E. A. Pierce, of Portland, who addressed the University students last week.

The great victory in the war upon tuberculosis is the remarkable test for detecting the disease. A drop of vaccine from each of three forms is placed upon the skin. If any one of them causes inflammation the patient beyond a doubt has that kind of tuberculosis and the physicians by that test know just what measures to take.

The doctor said: "Tuberculosis is one of the diseases for which nature has provided a remedy without medicine, and that cure is the only one. Plenty of fresh air and exercise are the two requirements, though good food aids in the fight. These measures are also the best preventatives."

### ONLY TWO VOTES AGAINST CHOOSING OF SENATORS BY PEOPLE

Salem, Jan. 26.—Only two senators (Beach of Multnomah and Smith of Marion) went on record today as opposed to the principle of election of United States senators by vote of the people. Free from any other phase of the question, the matter was presented on the adoption of a memorial to congress in favor of popular election, which was introduced by Mahone and adopted in the house. All the senators were present, and only the two negative votes were cast.

### FULTON'S MAN WINS AT ASTORIA

Washington, D. C., Jan. 27.—The senate this evening confirmed the nomination of Frank J. Carney as postmaster at Astoria. When Bourne consented to Carney's confirmation he wanted Fulton to withdraw his objection to John C. Young as postmaster at Portland, but Fulton declined to become a party to the deal.

## COURSE CHAMBERLAIN EXPECTS TO PURSUE

Salem, Jan. 26.—George E. Chamberlain will never resign the governorship. Such is the word that has been passed around the capital, and it seems to come from an authoritative source. He has not said that he will resign. What he has said is that he will be in attendance at the first session of congress, after his election as senator.

Instead of resigning the office of governor, he will let his acceptance of the office of senator act as a vacation of the office of governor. There will not be a fraction of a second of time between his ceasing to be governor and his becoming senator. If his credentials should be presented in the senate and he should be denied a seat, he would continue to be governor. If he should be seated and it be declared afterward that he had been improperly seated, he would resume the office of governor, since he would not have vacated that office.

That was the course the governor pursued when he was elected chief executive the first time. He was then district attorney in Multnomah county, and there were many who insisted that he resign the office of district attorney before taking the office of governor. This he refused to do, but let his acceptance of the office of governor have the effect of vacating the district attorney's office. If anything had occurred to prevent the inauguration, he would have remained in the office of district attorney.
