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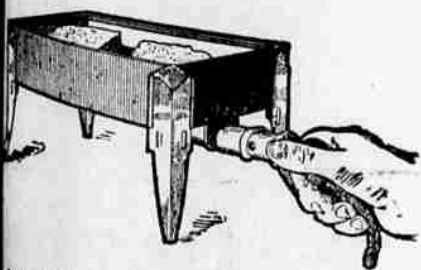

TAX ON GROSS EARNINGS OF CORPORATIONS UPHELD

Salem, Or., Feb. 2.—In an opinion written by Justice Bean, the supreme court today affirmed the decree of Judge Cleland, of the circuit court for Multnomah county, in the state, respondent, against the Pacific States Telephone & Telegraph Company, in which the constitutionality of the initiative and referendum amendment, adopted by the legislature in 1908, and by the people in 1906, is upheld, and the company is required to pay the annual license of 2 per cent upon its gross receipts and to make annual statements to the state treasurer. The case will probably be appealed to the United States supreme court.
