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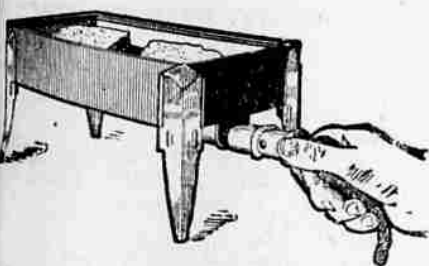

SEATTLE EXPO. OFFICIALS WANT COLLEGE ATHLETES

Ask That All Who May Possibly
Enter Meets to Write
to Them

The committee in charge of collegiate athletics at the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition wishes to hear from college athletes who may possibly enter the meets. The exposition opens in Seattle, Washington, on June 1st and closes on October 16th. The main exhibit buildings are now finished; the several state buildings, the grounds and concessions on the "Pay Streak" will be ready in every detail on the opening day. Alaska, Yukon territory, the Oriental countries and the various states will have very novel and attractive exhibits.

The athletic contests already arranged include a variety of special events, such as arm, navy, militia and the Y. M. C. A. sports, Marathon race, equestrian events, tennis, 8-oared, 4-oared and single-oared rowing, swimming, canoeing, lumbermen's sports and tug-of-war. The standard track and field events, relay races and cross-country runs will take place at the meet. In connection with it there will be a series of baseball, basketball and tennis matches, besides boxing, wrestling and other special features.

Relay races will be arranged between teams representing the Atlantic states, the Middle states, the Rocky Mountain states, the Pacific coast, Canada and the Western Indians.

WILL STILL FIGHT FOR NESMITH COUNTY

(Oregonian.)
Cottage Grove, Or., Feb. 5.—(To the Editor.)—The report in yesterday's Oregonian from the state capitol, makes Representative Jones, of Douglas county, say, opposing the creation of Nesmith county, that "the people residing in the territory of the proposed county were opposed to the bill and that Cottage Grove people alone were the sole advocates of the bill."

This statement is positively untrue. There are 70 odd petitions from various parts of the proposed new county and in fact from every precinct, containing 1200 names, and these signers not only voluntarily signed the petition, but worked for the new county. Cottage Grove is not alone in this fight, and the residents in the outlying districts did work and will continue to put forth their best efforts until Nesmith county is created. The people, although turned down by the legislature, are not whipped out or dismayed, and this measure will be put before the people of this state to vote on at the next state election. The people in the proposed Nesmith county are not going to be brow-beaten any longer than it is possible to be avoided and the dominant way in which the politics of Lane county is carried on, and the administration of the Lane county court is regarded as so unfair in the distribution of tax money that is collected from the people that the people in the new county will not sit idly by and continue to be hoodwinked any longer.
