MANY LARGE COUPONS ARE ISSUED TO CANDIDATES

This is an indication of the success which some of the candidates are pushing their campaign. To secure one of the grand prizes, the choice of the \$200 lot, or the naming of the chaparral for the party, seems to be the ambition of most of the candidates as the close draws near. The trip to the exposition promises to be most interesting of its kind ever offered by any newspaper in all the voting contests that have

The famous Liberty bell, now in the old state house at Philadelphia will be exhibited at the Portland Rose festival and the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition this summer.
An immense hippodrome is planned for the exposition by Martin Beck, head of the Orpheum circuit. In this big amusement house will be seen the latest vaudeville acts.
