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OREGON FOOTBALL TEAM TO PLAY AT SEATTLE ON THANKSGIVING DAY

Signs Up With University of
Washington in Place of An-
nual Multnomah Game

Seattle, Wash., Feb. 15.—The University of Oregon football team will play the University of Washington in Seattle Thanksgiving day. This announcement is made by Athletic Manager Victor Zednick, of the University of Washington, who has just returned from a trip to Eastern Washington, where he arranged for games with Whitman College, to be played in Seattle November 6, and with the University of Idaho, to be played in Spokane October 26.

This will be the first time that the University of Washington eleven has played in Eastern Washington for four years.

The arranging of a game with the University of Oregon in Seattle for Thanksgiving day puts an end to the talk that the University of Oregon team was to play Idaho in Portland on Turkey day. Zednick, says Manager Smith, of the University of Idaho, never seriously considered the proposition to play Oregon in Portland Thanksgiving day because he realized that it would be a poor stroke of business to invade the Rose City when the Multnomah Athletic Club and Oregon Agricultural College are scheduled to come together there.

EUGENE AND SALEM FIRMS COMBINE FOR RAISING CHICKENS

New Concern Originates Idea of
Raising Poultry in a
Hop Yard

Articles of incorporation were filed yesterday with the secretary of state for the Pacific Poultry and Pigeon Plant, which is a result of a combination of the Krebs-Reynolds Poultry farm and the Eugene Poultry Farm. The former has approximately 600 fancy chickens, including the White Plymouth Rock cock, which was estimated by Judge Denny to be worth \$1000, as well as three hens, prize winners, at \$200 each. The total stock is valued at \$3000. The original stock of this poultry farm was purchased from the Sears Poultry Farm of Tacoma, which was conceded to have the finest flock of White Plymouth Rocks in the West. The Eugene Poultry Farm has approximately 500 chickens, estimated to be worth \$5000. This firm has won 182 prizes in the last show season. This company has also purchased the entire flock of pigeons of the Mt. Scott pigeon loft of Lents, consisting of over 600 pairs of exhibition and working pigeons. The aim and object of this company is to increase the stock to a capacity of 20,000 laying hens, which will be the largest plant in the world. The new concern is originator of the idea of raising poultry in a hop yard. Squabs will be one of the features and it is said negotiations are now under way for disposing of the full squab product to Portland hotel people. Six hundred more pairs of pigeons will be secured by the firm. —Salem Statesman.

OLD PROSPECTOR DIES AT COTTAGE GROVE

Cottage Grove, Feb. 15.—J. B. Morgan, an old prospector, died today. He had located a number of properties in the Bohemia mining district during the last 17 years. Many of them were valuable. He served in the United States navy from 1861 to 1895. The funeral will be held tomorrow under the auspices of the C. A. R. He was 73 years of age.
