**JEALOUSY CAUSES
 MURDER OF ACTRESS**

Great Sensation Has Been
 Created in Capital of
 Kaiser's Empire

Berlin, April 21.—A great sensa-
 tion has been created by the murder
 of Fraulein Freda Barthold, a beau-
 tiful and talented young opera singer
 engaged at a theatre at Rostock, by
 Fraulein Augusta Zobel, whose
 grievance was that a young man to
 whom she was much attached had be-
 come engaged to Fraulein Barthold.
 Fraulein Barthold was the only
 daughter of a wealthy piano manu-
 facturer of Stettin. She was gifted
 not only with a voice of exceptional
 richness, but with a rare degree of
 personal beauty, and at the begin-
 ning of the musical season the mu-
 nicipal theatre of Mecklenburg en-
 gaged her. She had been trained by
 one of the greatest vocal teachers of
 Berlin, and had commenced her ca-
 reer by filling minor parts in the
 Emperor William's opera house.

On the night of the murder Fraulein
 Barthold was to have taken the
 chief feminine role in the "Tales of
 Hoffman," and an hour or so be-
 fore the performance was due to
 commence she was giving a singing
 lesson in her apartment. Suddenly
 a fashionably attired young woman
 called, in a state of violent agita-
 tion, and demanded an immediate
 private interview with the singer.
 The pupil was asked to step out for
 a few minutes, into an adjoining
 room.

While she waited she heard an in-
 terchange of angry words, followed
 by two shots. Other inmates of the
 house rushed into the room, where
 they found Fraulein Barthold lying
 dead on the floor, with a bullet in
 her head.

The murderess attempted flight,
 but was arrested at the railway sta-
 tion. According to her story she
 had lived for years in Paris, where
 she had become intimate with the
 agent of a large Berlin exporting
 firm. Recently her lover announced
 to her that their intimacy must come
 to an end, and shortly afterward she
 learned that he had betrothed him-
 self to Fraulein Barthold. Maddened
 by jealousy, she concealed a re-
 volver in her muff and shot her suc-
 cessful rival dead.

**BIG PROHIBITION
 FIGHT IN TEXAS**

Anti-Saloon Leaders Plan to
 Make Lone Star
 State Dry

San Antonio, Tex., April 20.—State-
 wide prohibition missed being a real-
 ity in Texas by an evanescent, failing
 of carrying in the present session of the
 legislature by such a narrow margin
 as to give the liquor interests a bad
 scare. It now develops that the pro-
 hibition element of Texas, far from
 feeling the temporary defeat, are
 elated at the close proximity to suc-
 cess which they attained, and are
 carefully mapping out their plans
 to make Texas a dry state within
 the next two years.

Prohibition leaders who have visit-
 ed San Antonio within the past few
 days express a firm conviction that
 victory will soon perch triumphantly
 on their banner, and they make no
 secret of their plans to force the fight
 to a decisive conclusion in this state.
 Chief among the measures which they
 will seek to have enforced in the
 meantime is the anti-treating law,
 arguing that treating is largely re-
 sponsible for such inebriety as exists.
 The Rev. G. W. Eichelberger, one
 of the most prominent of the anti-
 liquor forces, has arrived here from
 a tour of the state. He says that five
 counties are already willing and
 anxious to put the question of wet or
 dry to their voters in elections which
 will very likely be held in July or
 August. Mr. Eichelberger will de-
 vote two or three months to Bexar
 county. Every ward in the city of
 San Antonio and every precinct in
 the county will be thoroughly or-
 ganized, and prohibition clubs started
 in all of them.
