And now comes Adolphus Busch, of the great Anheuser-Busch Brewing company of St. Louis, plaintiff, to the Missouri legislature with his carload of brother tradesmen and friends. A comedy in two acts. First, they harangue the legislature three hours, proving conclusively that the people should not have the privilege of saying whether or not they want prohibition. Of course the arguments were spiced with exclamations of "personal liberty." Second act: Women were allowed ten minutes—just think of it—ten whole minutes to answer. It was sufficient. The women had copied from the clerk's book in St. Louis their tax assessments and showed by their own sworn statements that the invested capital of the brewers was 7 1-2 instead of 140 millions of dollars, as declared by them before the committee. A St. Louis paper—not favorable to these women's plea by the way—says: "The methods of these women are clear-cut and clean. We certainly need such politics in our state."

At the present rate of prohibitory victories the passing of the saloon will soon be an assured fact, and then Mr. Busch's great brewery, with many other such useless institutions, will also pass away. He has already threatened to move, but where will he go? Illinois says.

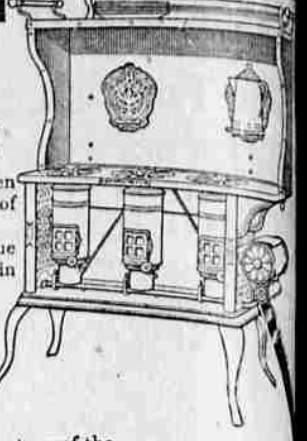
