#### HOW HANLEY

#### CONTROLLED LAND

Portland, May 27.—Evidence given today in the government's suit against William Hanley, the cattle king of Harney county, who is accused of illegally fencing 80,000 acres of public lands in Harney county, helped sustain the contention that the lands were barred against entrance by private individuals. R. A. Smith and Charles Wells, sheep growers of eastern Oregon, testified for the government, stating that the lands were not easy of access under the present condition, so they grazed their sheep outside. Frank C. Davey, receiver of the land office at Burns, showed how the original purchaser, Peter French, bought a series of forty acre tracts so connected that they completely circumscribed 80,000 acres, which, it is alleged, Hanley is keeping others from settling upon.

#### WESTON NORMAL IS TEMPORARILY CLOSED

The graduation exercises of Weston normal school were concluded Tuesday evening and the school property formally turned over by President French to the state board represented by E. Hofer of the executive committee. The property is worth about \$75,000 and will not be used for school purposes for the next two years. Former Secretary C. L. Starr of the board remained to complete the transfer by taking an inventory, selling off perishable stuff and putting all under lock and key, with a caretaker in charge of the grounds and buildings. The eastern Oregon normal students will scatter to the normal schools at Bellingham, Cheney and Lewiston. The faculty is all engaged at various places in the United States. President French accepts a fine position as educational director at the big new Y. M. C. A. at Portland, a work for which he is splendidly prepared.

#### SECRETARY BENSON

#### CITED TO APPEAR

Salem, Or., May 27.—William Galoway, of department No. 2 of the circuit court for Marion county, this morning issued an order of mandamus to the effect that Governor Frank Benson as secretary of state must appear in court on Tuesday, June 8, and show cause why he should not file the petition presented by W. S. U'Ren to refer to the people the act creating the new judgeship in Multnomah county. The order was obtained by Henry McGinn. A petition to refer the act was presented to the secretary of state last week. The governor directed the office to accept the petition upon the advice of Attorney General Crawford, who suggested that the matter be brought into court and finally settled.

The legal point involves the sufficiency of the emergency clause. It is upon the hypothesis that the emergency clause was defective that the petition was filed. The new judgeship is now filed by Judge W. N. Gatens.

#### McMAHAN BEGINS ANOTHER INJUNCTION

Salem, May 27.—L. H. McMahan, who thinks that he has stopped the expenditure of \$100,000 by the state for the Crater Lake road by filing proceedings in the circuit court of Marion county, has gone to Vale, Or., to file suit in that county enjoining the state treasurer from applying the funds appropriated by the legislature for the construction of a bridge across the Snake river from Ontario into Idaho. The treasurer of Malheur county has already obtained possession of the sum of \$100,000, but McMahan is on his trail.
