ZIONISTS HOLDING THEIR NATIONAL CONVENTION

W. C. A. of South and Jewish Meeting—Two Other Important Gatherings

New York, June 12.—Zionists from all parts of the country are gathering here for the twelfth annual convention of the Federation of American Zionists which will be in session during the next three days. The most important question to be considered by the convention is the movement seeking the restoration of Palestine to the Jewish people.

Southern Y. W. C. A.
Asheville, N. C., June 12.—The annual conference of the Young Women's Christian Associations of the South opened at the Normal School here today and will continue until the 21st. Several hundred young women, representing nearly every southern state, are present.

Jubilee of Brith Abraham.
New York, June 12.—From all parts of the country members of the Brith Abraham, the greatest of Jewish fraternal and benevolent orders, have gathered in this city for a five days' celebration of the organization's jubilee. The order was founded in this city in 1859. In fifty years it has spread from Maine to California, and now numbers 340 local lodges with an aggregate membership of 63,000. In the fifty years of its existence the order has distributed over \$10,000,000 in sick and death benefits and in relieving other cases of distress.

Those Next Week.
New York, June 12.—Republicans of Pennsylvania will meet in state convention at Harrisburg, Wednesday, to nominate candidates for state treasurer, attorney general and one justice of the state supreme court.

Other conventions and gatherings of the week that will attract more or less attention will be the meeting of the International Council of Women in Toronto, the National Association of Credit Men in Philadelphia, the North American Skat League, opening in Milwaukee Saturday, and the council of "the alliance of the reformed churches throughout the world holding the Presbyterian system," which will begin its sessions Tuesday morning in New York city.
