DISSATISFIED WITH THE NEW TRAIN SCHEDULE

No Passengers Taken on New Train—Inconvenient Service From Here.

The traveling public in general is dissatisfied with the new train schedule which went into effect today. There was an error in the time card in last night's Guard. No. 14 is given as coming in at 5:30 p. m., when it should have read 5:30 a. m. No passengers will be taken on the new train which passes through here going north at 5:21 p. m. This cuts out an evening train for Portland and there are no trains on which passengers can go to Portland between 12:22 at noon and 2:43 o'clock the next morning, which is as bad as before. No. 14 was put on several years ago. The Cottage Grove local passes through, going north at the unseemly hour of 4:30 in the morning, but it comes through an hour later. This helps some, but it is half an hour earlier than the Cottage Grove local used to be, and that was early enough. There seems to be little kick on the time of the arrival of the south bound trains.

MR. SLATTERY EXPLAINS CHARTER AMENDMENT

To the Editor.—The charter given to the City of Eugene by the Legislature in 1905 expressly grants to the Common Council the power to license, tax, regulate, or prohibit the sale of intoxicating liquors within the city limits. But the method of procedure is provided in our charter whereby the unlawful sale of intoxicating liquors may be prohibited—nothing stated relative to what the Council may do to enforce the law. It is on account of this deficiency in the charter that bootlegging and blind pigs have caused so much annoyance. The sole purpose of the proposed amendment of the charter relating to intoxicating liquors is not to grant the Council additional power to license the sale thereof but to place in its hands the means and measures whereby that it may effectively prevent the unlawful traffic. If this amendment is carried then the Council will have power to search all places where intoxicating liquor is unlawfully sold, furnished, or given away; and will also have power to seize and condemn the liquor. In many other states this method has proven itself to be both quick and effective. All citizens in our fair city who desire to see the bootlegging and blind pigs to be things of the past will be permitted to do so if they will make an earnest effort to have this charter amendment carry. If this fails to carry it will be a signal victory for the element who desire to see the saloon on every corner, a gambling hell beneath, and some other institution above; and the Common Council could no longer consistently attempt to enforce the Intoxicating Liquor laws by the present defective charter method, because experience shows it to be futile. Neither could we reasonably expect it to do so. The rumblers are making a "still hunt" for votes to defeat the proposed amendment; hence good citizens go to election on June 8th and vote for the amendment.

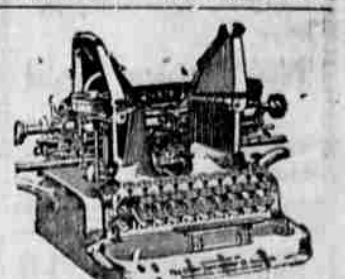
