July 8th, 1909, at the office of the City Recorder of said city, for the improvement of the alley between Willamette and Oak streets from 7th street to Park street in the City of Eugene, by paving said alley over its entire width between said points with bitulphic, asphalt or other hard surface pavement, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor now on file in the office of the City Recorder.
