SHIPPING CHERRIES TO SOUTHERN OREGON

Many Boxes Go to Grants Pass, Medford and Other Towns

Manager Holt has quite a good-sized force employed at the packing house of the Eugene Fruit Growers' Association engaged in packing cherries for shipment. He reports a good demand from Southern Oregon, one hundred boxes having been sent to Grants Pass yesterday, while Medford and other towns have had orders filled. The best market, however, is in Seattle, where the bulk of the pack goes.

The cherries are carefully sorted and packed in layers, and only the best grades are accepted. This system naturally sends the larger part of the local crop to the cannery, where the receipts are much heavier than at the packing house.

OBITUARY.

Alfred Miner, a well-known figure in early Oregon history, died at the home of his son, at Acme, on Wednesday, June 7, 1909, aged 76 years one month and ten days. Death was due to general debility caused from old age. Mr. Miner came to Oregon in the ox-team days of 1863, settling first in the Grand Ronde valley and later coming to Salem, Oregon and from there to Lane County, where he has resided continuously throughout the last thirty-five years.

Mr. Miner was a man of sterling principle and while he never amassed a great fortune in the world's goods, still he was rich in strict integrity, temperance and moral fortitude. He was a man whose word was his bond and who did much to promote the pioneer honesty of the early settlements in the Willamette valley. He was of the Jacksonian line of political faith and was familiarly known about the courthouse in Eugene in the days of the Campbells and later in Sheriff Withers' time. He leaves one living son, Alfred A. Miner, of Acme, Oregon, and two daughters, Mrs. T. M. Martin, of Eugene, and Mrs. P. A. Wegner, of Camp Creek, Oregon. His wife and two daughters preceded him to the Great Beyond. In his death the Grim Reaper has displaced another landmark of the early Oregon pioneers.
