OVER TWELVE TONS OF FRUIT HANDLED EACH DAY AT THE ALLEN CANNERY

"The growers of cherries and loganberries bring in twelve or fifteen tons a day to our cannery," said W. G. Allen this afternoon. "The day before yesterday we shipped two car loads of cherries to Chicago, and we are ready to ship more than another car today."

In the cannery nearly fifty girls are working preparing the luscious Royal Anne cherries for cans and for shipment, and the tart biting loganberries for canning. About fifteen men are also working in the cannery.

Mr. Allen said the cherries are in good shape now, though a few of them are still cracked.
