GREAT CANALS CUT THROUGH SOLID ROCK

Black Irrigation Project Is of Greater Magnitude Than People Think

Few people in Eugene realize the magnitude of the work being done on the Black Irrigation reservoir project at Waldo lake, at the summit of the Cascade Mountains, over a hundred miles east of here. Engineer Simon Klovdehl, who has charge of the work, returned from the lake last evening. Today he informed a Guard reporter that the big canal known as the Black cut had been completed and the crew of workmen have begun on the cut from the lake to Salmon creek.

The Black cut extends from the edge of the lake through solid rock almost the entire distance to North Fork. This cut is about 800 feet in length, ten feet wide at the bottom

and six feet deep. The North Fork will carry the water from this ditch to the main artery of the Willamette river thence to the valley where it will be used for irrigation purposes when the big project is completed.

The ditch leading from the lake to Salmon creek will take even more work than the Black cut to construct. While it will be 200 feet shorter than the other one, it will be 25 feet deep and about the same width as the first one. Salmon creek also flows into a tributary of the Willamette and the water from this canal will also find its way into the valley.

A. R. Black and associates have been working on this project for the past four years, and have expended many thousands of dollars in building this canal through the rock. The building of the Salmon creek canal is a still greater undertaking, and will cost a great deal more than the first one did.
