Do reputable dealers misrepresent in their advertising?

A certain firm in Eugene is advertising 3,500,000 Post Cards at one cent each.

We haven't that many cards in stock. I don't believe we have over 250,000 cards, possibly we haven't over 200,000.

I will give \$25.00 to charity if and three ladies in Eugene will invoice any stock of Post Cards in the city which shows more cards than we are carrying.

If any dealer in the city has 3,500,000 cards at one cent each in stock he has a right to advertise the fact, which means that, at retail, he is carrying \$35,000.00 worth of penny post cards. It also means that these cards weigh, approximately, 35,000 pounds, and that piled one on top of the other they would make a stack of cards 3,000 feet in height. These same cards placed end to end would reach a distance of 300 miles.

'Fake Sales' Law

Passed at Salem during the session of the State Legislature, and will prove of interest to the trade generally, as aiming at an evil

Section 1. Any firm, person, corporation or association of persons, or any employe of such, or any such who, in the newspapers or other periodicals of this state, or in public advertisements, or in communications intended for a larger number of persons, knowingly makes or disseminates any statements, or assertion of facts, with respect to his, its or their business affairs concerning its quantity, the value, the price, the method of production or manufacture, or the fixing of the price of its, his or their merchandise, or professional work, or the manner or source of purchase of such merchandise, or in the possession of awards, prizes or distinctions, or the motive or purpose of a sale, intended to have the appearance of an advantageous offer which is or are untrue or calculated to mislead, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Any person, persons or association of persons, firms of corporation, violating any of the provisions of this act, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding 20 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.—Valley Record.
