EASTERN MAIL IS DELAYED BY O. R. & N.

Business Suffers Because Railroad Has No Competition

Lacking competition to compel quick service, the O. R. & N. has Portland at its mercy in the matter of overland mail deliveries. Towns along the Columbia river and in the Willamette valley are similarly forced to wait until it suits the convenience of the railroad company to turn the mail over to the proper authorities.

This was admitted by F. E. Whitney, chief of the railway mail service for the Oregon division, according to a Portland report. Unwilling to censure the railroad company, he nevertheless said:

"Our mail contract gives us no power over the railroad company to compel them to make quick deliveries. They contract to handle the mail at so much a ton. Having no competition such as is found in other localities, the railroad feels free to bring in mail in conformity with the easiest schedule."

Complaints from residents of towns in the Willamette valley called attention to the tardy delivery of overland mail. It was found that O. R. & N. train No. 11, due to arrive in Portland at 6 p. m., making the transfer of mail to both the Southern Pacific and A. & C. trains leaving at the same hour, was being held back in order to miss the connection, making it necessary to send Columbia river mail out by boat and the Willamette valley consignment on a train leaving Portland after midnight. Mail clerks on the O. R. & N. train testify that they are held at Gresham, just outside the city, until the other trains have left the Union depot.

HOPS ARE BIG MONEY MAKER

Offer Attractive Field for Investor in This Beautiful Region

The hop grower in Oregon has come into his own again. It is expected that the hop crop in this state alone will bring a return of over \$3,500,000 this year. Oregon will produce about 70,000 bales of hops, and they are now selling at 21 cents a pound. The price will go to the 30-cent mark in a few weeks, and optimistic growers look for an even higher price.

Hops have always been a great crop in the Willamette valley. Salem has long been considered the hop center of the world, and many a fortune has been made in the crop in this city.

The hop crop of the world is uniformly poor this year, but the Oregon crop leads in comparison with others, and consequently Oregon growers will receive the greatest percentage of the benefits derived therefrom.

Because of the poor world crop the market has been shooting skyward, and prices advanced five cents in a single week.

It has not been necessary to make any attempt to bull the market this year, as the growers and brewers are both so well informed as to the general situation that the prices have gone up regardless of any deceptions on the part of purchasers to the contrary.

Hops have always proven to be a good thing around Salem, and prove very attractive to the prospective investor.—Salem Statesman.

OVER \$6000 FOR PROMOTION WORK SO FAR THIS YEAR

Sum Divided Between Depot Park, Exhibit and Literature

At the meeting of the board of governors of the promotion department of the Eugene Commercial Club, besides routine business, a detailed statement of the 1909 expenditures was submitted and discussed. It shows that the total cost of the depot park to date is \$2029 and the cost of the Eugene exhibit at Seattle to date nearly \$1000 with \$500 more due for salaries for the rest of the exposition. The total expended for literature aggregates \$2334 and for postage for the first seven months of the year is \$686. For entertaining visiting conventions etc. \$243 was spent, which includes the illuminating and decorating of Willamette street.

ELMIRA PEOPLE GIVE RAILROAD PROMOTERS MUCH ENCOURAGEMENT

Offers of Assistance Much Better Than Expected—Meeting Largely Attended

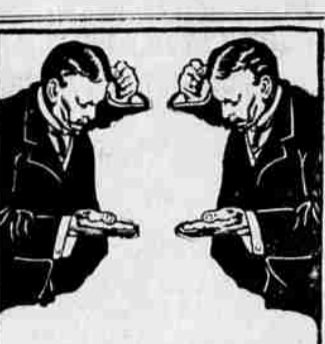
