Being one of the 15 leading rifle teams of the United States, the Oregon men will have to fight for the National trophy in class A, being pitted against the regular army, navy, marine corps, and the pick of the National Guard teams. One thousand riflemen, representing all branches of the United States service, are now assembled here for the national matches.
