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INDIANS REBUKE

PRESIDENT TAFT

Flag That Floated Over the
White House Returned As
a Political Trophy

Muskogee, Okla., Aug. 23.—It be-
came known today that the Kee Too
Wah society, which is composed of
full-blooded Cherokee Indians, has
administered a rebuke to President
Taft that probably rankles deep in the
presidential brain.

Congressman Charles Kreeger, who
has returned from Washington,
brought with him the handsome
American flag that floated over the
White House the day that Taft as-
sumed the directorship of the desti-
nies of the nation. The flag was en-
trusted to Kreeger to be presented in
behalf of President Taft to the In-
dian society.

Late yesterday the executive com-
mittee of the redmen's organization
met and drafted a set of resolutions,
a copy of which was sent to Kreeger.
The Indians announced that they are
desirous of inculcating the principles
of Christianity among their young
men; that their organization is in no
sense a political one, and therefore if
the flag is a trophy of the recent Re-
publican victory at the National polls
it must be refused with thanks.

BIG TIMBER DEAL

IN LINN COUNTY

Portland Parties Buy 2500
Acres Near Brownsville
for \$45,000.00

Brownsville, Or., Aug. 23.—The
largest sale of timber land recorded
in Linn county for a number of years
has just taken place here, the lands
involved in the transfer being known
as the Martin tract, owned by local
people, consisting of approximately
2500 acres, situated on the north
slope of the divide between the Cala-
pooa and Mohawk rivers. The price
paid for the land was close on to \$45,-
000, the purchaser being the Crossett
Timber Company, of Portland.

It is surmised that the land goes
into the hands of speculators. Brown-
sville is only four and a half miles dis-
tant from the land, which is admir-
ably situated for logging and milling.

HAMLIN IS FACING

SENTENCE FOR LIFE

Twice Convicted, Third Sen-
tence in Washington Car-
ries Severe Penalty

Portland, Aug. 24.—Jack Hamlin's
career of forgery has brought him
face to face with life imprisonment
in the penitentiary if he should be
convicted under the laws of Washing-
ton. In the county jail yesterday
Hamlin admitted that he had served
two terms in the penitentiary for for-
gery. Under the laws of Washington,
the only penalty that can be imposed
on the third conviction is life in the
penitentiary.

Pinkerton detectives have a list of
11 banks which Hamlin is said to
have victimized by his clever scheme
of forgery since March. His arrest
was effected on a charge of securing
\$300 from the bank at Winlock,
Wash., on a forged note.
