MULKEY MAY DECIDE TO RUN FOR CONGRESS

"I have not yet made up my mind whether to contest with Congressman Hawley the nomination for representative for this district," said District Attorney B. F. Mulkey, of Jacksonville, who was in Eugene a couple of days ago, and whose candidacy was recently announced in a Portland paper. "I have been urged by many friends to make the race, for there is great dissatisfaction with Mr. Hawley's course. If I were a wealthy man, I could answer off-hand, but being poor, I do not know as I can afford to run." The only other probable candidate against Mr. Hawley at this time is W. K. Newell, president of the state board of horticulture and a former member of the lower house of the Oregon assembly. Mr. Hawley has managed to antagonize the state grange, and it is evident that they will largely support anyone who makes the race.

Congressman Hawley is reported to have met with a frost at Coos Bay, where he made a speech at the development congress. After telling about the tariff and stories of Oregon he was asked what had been done to deepen the harbor at Coos Bay and his reply was not very satisfactory. Some one told what Binger Hermann had done in Congress and Mr. Hermann received an ovation.

Should Mr. Hermann decide to contest the nomination with Mr. Hawley, the latter would have hard sailing.

WINDOW LIGHTING

ASSURED FOR NEXT

SIXTEEN MONTHS

Willamette Valley Co. Makes a Flat Rate Again for Store Window Lights

At the last meeting of the Merchants' Protective Association a committee consisting of W. M. Green, president of the association, and Manager Hartog, of the Commercial Club, was appointed to make the best possible arrangement with the Willamette Valley Company in regard to window lighting in the stores. The company had decided to put all those lights on meters, but after further negotiations with the committee Manager Lambirth agreed to continue the lights on a flat rate if some way could be found by which his company would be safeguarded as to the quantity of electricity consumed under the flat rate.

The committee secured a flat rate of 40 cents per month for a 40-watt Tungsten lamp, or 16 candlepower old-style burner if preferred, and got most everybody along Willamette street to sign up today. The contract assures window lighting for the next sixteen months, or up to the end of next year. Manager Lambirth now has the contract, and any one not found in by the committee can go to him and add his name to the contract, for without doing so the special rate will not be allowed.

The owners of the Cody mill, at Bandon, which was entirely destroyed by fire a few days ago, have announced that the mill will be rebuilt at once. Two steamers, the Fifield and Bandon, were engaged in carrying lumber from the mill, and other industries depended upon it for lumber. The chief owners in the Cody Lumber Company are Colonel L. Cody and Colonel J. F. Church, of Bandon, George Moore, of Port Haron, and M. J. McKenna, secretary, Bandon.
