## IN THE World of Sport

### O. A. C. STARTS SAME

#### OLD STORY OF POOR TEAM THIS YEAR

O. A. C. has started, through the columns of the state press, its annual "hard luck" story, telling how poor the prospects are for its football team this year. This is getting to be an old "gag" and very little credit is given to it among football men. Their object for circulating this report every year is presumably to give their opposing teams over confidence, and, possibly, to show what a "remarkable" development such and such a coach which they had secured had made from such a poor outlook which perhaps may attract a few good men the next year.

### MULTNOMAH WILL

#### PLAY IN EUGENE

There has been some question among football enthusiasts since the announcement that Oregon and Multnomah would not play in Portland on Thanksgiving day this season, whether the loss of the money annually received from this game would make any material difference to this year's finances.

Although it is probable that there will not be so much money on hand at the end of this season as there was last it is quite probable, especially if the team turns out to be as good as it looks now, that the games with the U. of W. at Seattle and Idaho at Portland will easily draw the crowds that will maybe more than make up the one game.

When O. A. C. plays here there is expected to be the greatest crowd that was ever on Kincaid Field. It is known that Portland will bring over a thousand on a special train. There may be difficulty in handling the crowds. Besides the income from the games, 20 per cent of the student body tax goes to football.

### MCARTHUR SAYS HE'S

#### QUIT ATHLETIC SPORTS

"Father of Athletics" at University of Oregon Has Too Much Business

Portland, Sept. 21.—C. N. McArthur, speaker of Oregon's legislature, secretary to Governor Benson, is telling all his friends that he is out of athletics for good.

Such talk from "Pat" McArthur, called the "Father of Athletics" by all University of Oregon students, cannot be taken seriously the first time it is sprung, for athletics are as natural to him as politics, and he takes to both like a duck to water. For ten years he has been one of the best known athletic figures in the state, as a player, a writer and organizer, and even if he does withdraw from the active councils of the State University's athletics, he will be called upon occasionally when big questions come up.

Mr. McArthur arranged the first interstate track meet between Washington and Oregon in 1906, when in college, and in later years, while practicing law in Portland, managed the Oregon-Idaho game in 1907 and the Oregon-O. A. C. game in 1908.

### EUREKA, CALIFORNIA.

#### TO GET RAILROAD

San Francisco, Sept. 19.—Captain A. H. Payson, president of the Northwestern Pacific, which is owned jointly by the Santa Fe and Southern Pacific, has just announced that the gap between Eureka and Sherwood, a distance of 195 miles, will be closed and work on the line will be started soon.

An appropriation of \$2,000,000 has been made to start construction. The railroad will open up the northwestern part of California, and give means of transporting the lumber of Humboldt and the north coast country to market.

The only mode of communication at present is by wagon road and by water. The proposed construction of the road has been under consideration for several years. A month ago Captain Payson went to Chicago, where he urged the construction of the line before President Ripley of the Santa Fe and Julius Kruttschnitt, director of maintenance and operation of the Harriman system.
