FIGHTERS MAY SPLIT ON REFEREE CHOICE

Chicago, Sept. 27.—Final arrangements for the proposed heavyweight championship fight between Jim Jeffries and Jack Johnson will be made in Chicago next month, according to a letter sent to New York by Jeffries. He plans to return to America in two weeks, and expects to meet Johnson in Chicago. The present champion will leave the coast for Chicago immediately after his fight with Stanley Ketchel, October 10. It is expected that the match will be closed about October 20.

If the two heavyweights get together next month, they will have lived up to their preliminary articles, which say the final articles must be signed within sixty days.

The fighters are expected to have trouble over the referee question. This is one of the important parts of a big event, and it is thought the men will have much difficulty in selecting a man whom they think will give them a square deal.

S. P. ASSESSMENT JUMPS TO \$38,000

Medford, Sept. 27.—The Southern Pacific will pay taxes on this year's assessment on a valuation of \$38,000 per mile on its road through Jackson county. The valuation on the tax roll for 1906 was \$39,000 a mile. The basis for the increase in valuation made by Assessor W. T. Grieve was that the Southern Pacific railroad, in an affidavit before the state railroad commission, had placed a cash value of \$365,000 per mile on its roads in Oregon. The company has 58.2 miles of road in Jackson county, which by the new valuation will amount to \$2,111,000. The Southern Pacific is also a large taxpayer on land in Jackson county, having had a land grant of every other section for 20 miles each side of the road. Most of this land is still held by the company, for the land was withdrawn from the market nine years ago. Most of it is valuable timber, mineral and fruit land.

YOUNG BRIDEGROOM KILLED LAWRENCE

McMinnville, Or., Sept. 27.—James Townsend last night shot from his front door into a crowd of charivariers and instantly killed James Lawrence. Townsend had been recently married and a crowd of his neighbors and their wives started to charivari him. One of the crowd entered his house and this seemed to anger Townsend. The murder followed. Townsend gave himself up to the sheriff about midnight.

Lawrence, the murdered man, was about 30 years old. He leaves a widow and 10 children, several of them under 12 years of age. The bullet ranged down through his neck, cutting his jugular vein and breaking his neck.

Townsend was married about a week ago for the second time. He has five grown children. Both men are favorably known in Yamhill county, having lived near McMinnville many years.
