MINISTER CRANE OFF FOR CHINA

New Diplomat Leaves for the Orient from New York

New York, Oct. 6.—Charles R. Crane, of Chicago, the new minister to China, sailed today for his post. He will take the Siberian railroad across Asia and will arrive at Peking early next month.

It is expected that Mr. Crane will be a valuable ally to President Taft in carrying out his eastern policy, which is one of progress and development. This policy was announced by Mr. Taft in a speech he made at Shanghai, while touring the world, and which has become almost classic as representing the commercial alliance between the United States and the Dragon Empire.

According to that speech, the President is opposed to the adaptation of the colonial policy in the opening of China. To him the "open door" has a broad meaning, which unselfishly looks beyond the possibilities of trade to the future life of the empire.

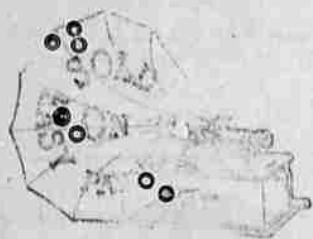
