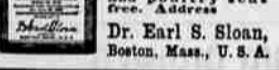

OREGON STUDENTS AT HARVARD AND OTHER COLLEGES

Loris Johnson Ranks as Best Tutor for English and Classics at Cambridge

Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass., Oct. 26.—Loris H. Johnson, son of the first president of the University of Oregon and a Eugene boy, who was graduated from Oregon six or seven years ago, is now ranked as best tutor in Cambridge for English and classics. Cambridge tutors receive \$2.50 an hour and upwards for services, and Johnson has received from some of his millionaires \$7.50 an hour in the rush of tutoring before examinations.

He is a brother of Wistar Johnson, who is now in Oxford University. Both men were Oregon handball champions, and prominent in other lines.

Heads Wistar, Loris has two other brothers, one, Rev. Herbert S. Johnson, a leading Boston minister, and the other, Rev. Virgil Johnson, pastor of an influential church in Concord, New Hampshire. Loris Johnson has attended Harvard for four years, having received an A. M. degree, and having completed a part of the work for a doctor literature degree.

Other Oregon Students.

Ormond Bean, another Eugene boy, Oregon '09, is registered in his first year at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, which is ranked as the leading scientific college of the Atlantic Coast. The first ten men in the graduating class of each year have standing offers from large engineering firms, with salaries to begin with averaging almost \$2000.

Charles McSnow, Oregon '09; Oscar Furuset, Oregon '08, whose family lives in Eugene, are attending the Harvard law school with the aim of completing a three years' course. About 750 law students are registered.

Earl F. Strong is in the graduate school of Arts and Sciences, studying economics. Nelson Gammans, a Portland lad, who attended the University of Oregon last year, is a member of "Harvard '13". He says that hazing is a thing of tradition in Cambridge.

SIUSLAW MEN FINED FOR HAVING FISH NETS TOO LONG

J. N. Frederickson and I. O. Fosback Each Pay Fine of Fifty Dollars

Tom Stark and John Bundy, who have been working on Eugene's power canal, east of that city, returned to Florence last Friday.

The Oregon & California Lumber Company's mill resumed sawing on Tuesday morning, having obtained a new supply of logs.

J. W. West, of Eugene, made a trip to the mouth of the Siuslaw Tuesday afternoon.

The schooner Hugh Hogan arrived here Wednesday morning, having made the run up from San Francisco in six days. She is loading at the Siuslaw Lumber Company's mill.

Born—To Mr. and Mrs. Ole I. Fosbak, near Acme, Friday, October 22, 1909, a daughter Leva was splitting kindling wood Wednesday morning, he struck the forefinger of his left hand with the axe and cut the finger nearly off. He hastened to Dr. Edwards, who found the bone cut entirely off. He dressed the wound and took several stitches in the finger, and hopes to save it.

Last Monday a complaint was filed by M. C. Jensen before D. E. Severy, Justice of the peace for Florence district, charging J. N. Frederickson and I. O. Fosback with violating the law by setting nets more than one-third the way across the Siuslaw river. Frederickson and Fosback pleaded guilty and Justice Severy sentenced each to pay a fine of \$50. The amount was at once paid by each of the parties.—Florence West.

LONG PRISON TERM FOR MURDERER

Leavenworth, Kan., Oct. 31.—Jas. McMahon was placed in the penitentiary here today to begin a "297-year term" for the killing of his brother-in-law, Alonzo Van Hoyon. Mrs. Van Hoyon and his sister, Rose McMahon, McMahon had planned for three years to kill them. Following the triple murder the man assisted the sheriff in his search for the murderer. Last week he walked into the office of the sheriff and announced that he was ready to help continue the search for the slayer, when he was arrested on evidence which had been discovered by the officials accidentally.

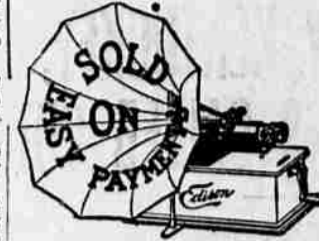
McMahon was immediately imprisoned, and after a few weak denials he confessed. He gave no reason for killing his relatives other than a desire to murder.

He was sentenced to serve 99 years for each murder.

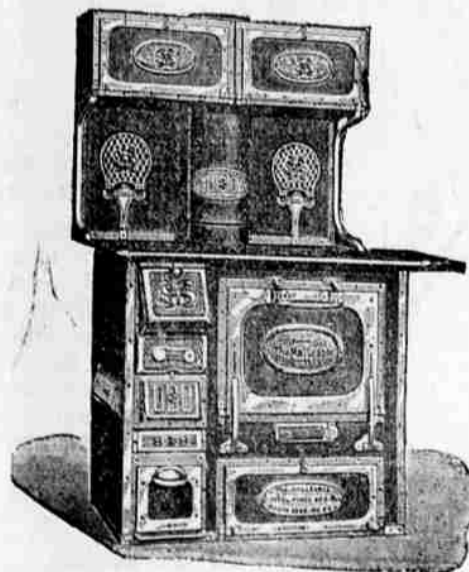
