NORTHERN PACIFIC BUYING TERMINALS

Fourteen Blocks Secured in the
Northwestern Part of
Portland

Portland, Dec. 24.—Options on 14 blocks in the northwestern part of the city have been secured by the Northern Pacific railroad for terminal yards, the transactions being conducted quietly for Jerome H. Gossage for the railroad interests. That the huge deal has been made for Hill was said unintentionally by Mr. Gossage last night.

Options have been obtained on the greater part of 14 blocks in Blackstone's and Sherlock's addition, in the northwestern part of the city, for \$1,362,500. Additional terminal facilities for the Northern Pacific railroad are gained by the acquisition of this large piece of land. The buying has been so swift and so quiet that it was fully accomplished before landowners in that part of the city realized what was on foot.

The Northern Pacific railroad and the James J. Hill interests are back of the purchase, despite the flat assertion of Mr. Gossage to the contrary. Mr. Gossage was not especially communicative concerning the deal, but discussed it, saying he had finished his task and was enroute to Seattle for his Christmas dinner. He left on the Southern Pacific train for California late last night.

MYSTERY OF AIR CREATES SENSATION

Wareham, Mass., Dec. 22.—Flying at a speed of 50 to 60 miles an hour, a mysterious airship tonight hovered over the city for a few minutes, disappeared for about two hours, and then returned to cut four circles above the city, using a searchlight of tremendous power. Thousands of persons thronged the streets to watch the mysterious visitor.

Observers set the height of the machine at 2000 feet, too great to enable even the precise shape to be seen. The glaring rays of a great searchlight, however, were sharply defined. At the time of the airship's visit Wallace Tillamuth, a Wareham man who recently claimed to have invented a marvelous aeroplane in which he said he had journeyed to New York and return, by way of Boston, was absent from his home and could not be found. The visitor from the clouds was first seen about 5:20 o'clock over Marlborough. The six-ton miles between Marlborough and this city were covered in about 20 minutes.

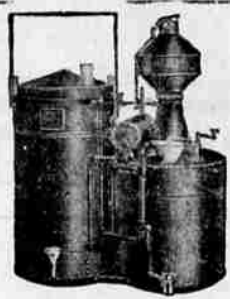
